

ORDINANCE NO. 1438

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL HOLIDAY, TO WIT: WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title I, Chapter 6, Section 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-6-2: HOLIDAYS: Every employee of the City, in addition to earned vacation, shall be entitled to vacation on the following holidays during each year:

If any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered as the legal holiday. If any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be considered as the legal holiday. All full time employees in the service of the City shall be entitled to time off for legal holidays when such holidays fall on regularly scheduled work days, as provided in the Civil Service Rules of the City of Las Vegas.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




