

ORDINANCE NO. 1436

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 10, SUBSECTION M OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE FOR MUTUAL FUND BROKER-DEALER LICENSE FEES AND TO DECREASE THE LICENSE FEE FOR MUTUAL FUND SALESMAN; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 1, Section 10, Subsection M of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-1-10: (M)

1. Marble or Granite Workers' Shop: (See Granite Workers' Shop)
2. Massage Parlor: (See Title V, Chapter 29)
3. Mechanical Games or Devices: (See Coin Operated Amusement Machines)
4. Menagerie: (See Traveling Shows)
5. Mercantile Agency: (See Collection Agency)
6. Merry-Go-Round: For each merry-go-round or carrousel, \$5.00 per day.
7. Message Center: For each message center, \$50.00 semiannually.
8. Motor Fuel Oil: (See Dealers in Gasoline, Motor Fuel or Lubricating Oil Not Used on Highways)
9. Music, Furnished from Central Location and Delivered Through Music Box: The business of furnishing continuous and uninterrupted music transmitted from any central location and delivered through the medium of a music box or other outlet, other than coin operated, in the premises of the purchaser shall pay a license fee of \$50.00 semiannually for the operation of five (5) outlets and an additional fee of \$10.00 semiannually for each outlet in excess thereof.
10. Music Machines: (See Juke Boxes)
11. Mutual Fund Broker-Dealer: For each mutual fund broker-dealer, \$50.00 semiannually.
12. Mutual Fund Salesman: For each mutual fund salesman, \$10.00 semiannually.


SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

- 7. Message Center: For each message center, \$50.00 semiannually.
- 8. Motor Fuel Oil: (See Dealers in Gasoline, Motor Fuel or Lubricating Oil Not Used on Highways)
- 9. Music, Furnished from Central Location and Delivered Through Music Box: The business of furnishing continuous and uninterrupted music transmitted from any central location and delivered through the medium of a music box or other outlet, other than coin operated, in the premises of the purchaser shall pay a license fee of \$50.00 semiannually for the operation of five (5) outlets and an additional fee of \$10.00 semiannually for each outlet in excess thereof.

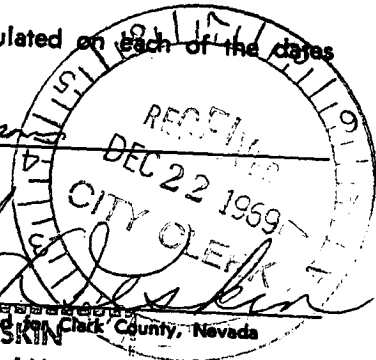
