

ORDINANCE NO. 1435

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF LOST, ABANDONED OR CONFISCATED PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE POSSESSION OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to read as follows:

Any personal property acquired by the City of Las Vegas, whether by confiscation, abandonment or being lost, may be disposed of by the City in the manner following:

1. The Procurement Officer of the City shall maintain a record of all such property in the City's possession.
2. Upon the expiration of sixty (60) days after the said property has come into the possession of the City, the Procurement Officer is authorized to conduct a sale of all such property unclaimed. Said sale shall be conducted as follows:
 - a. Notice of such sale shall be given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the County, with said publication to appear twice within a period of ten (10) days with at least five (5) days intervening between such advertisement.
 - b. The notice shall state:
 - (1) A general description of the property to be sold;
and
 - (2) The time and place where the sale will be conducted.
 - c. Such sale shall be conducted by public auction or by sealed bids under the direction of the Procurement Officer.

In the event no bids are received on the property or the

bids received are rejected by the City, the Procurement Officer shall report to the City Commission such fact, together with a description of the property. The City Commission may thereafter direct that the property be given to any recognized charitable organization, retained by the City, or disposed of as the City Commission shall direct.


- d. Sales shall be for cash, certified check or money order.
- e. Proceeds of said sales, after the payment of necessary costs, shall be deposited in the City General Fund.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

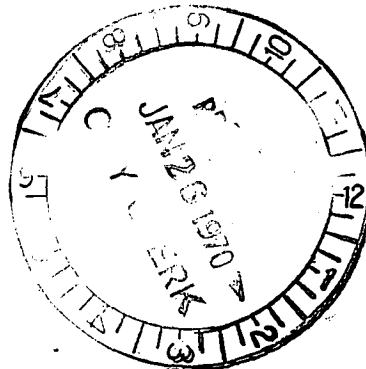

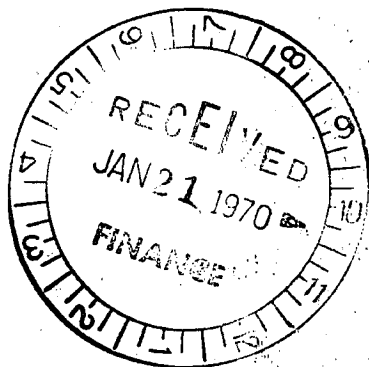
