

ORDINANCE NO. 1431

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE II, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 2, SUBSECTION A OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING FAMILY CARE HOMES; TO AMEND TITLE II, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 2 OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBSECTION, TO BE DESIGNATED SUBSECTION H, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF COMPUTING THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN NURSERY SCHOOLS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title II, Chapter 5, Section 2, Subsection A of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-5-2: (A) A "Family Care Home" is any family home in which one (1) or more, but not more than six (6) children under sixteen (16) years of age, not related by blood, adoption or marriage to the persons maintaining the home, are received, cared for and maintained for compensation, or otherwise, for any period of time. Those children, under nine (9) years of age, related by blood, adoption or marriage to the persons maintaining the home will be included in the total number of six (6). The license issued shall specify the number of children to be received and cared for, excluding the Family Care Home mother's own children. Children of school age who are being cared for by the licensee will count in the total number of daytime children. A Family Care Home license may authorize child care on a twenty-four (24) hour basis, or on a daytime basis only, or both, and the number of children which may be received and cared for at one time shall not exceed the number specified in the license. Not more than two (2) children in a Family Care Home may be infants under the age of two (2) years.

SECTION 2. Title II, Chapter 5, Section 2 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be designated Subsection H, to read as follows:

2-5-2: (H) All children in care, except in Family Care Homes, shall be counted in the total number, including children of the director and staff members, in relation to personnel and physical facility requirements.


SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE II, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 2, SUBSECTION A OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING FAMILY CARE HOMES; TO AMEND TITLE II, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 2 OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING THERETO TO A NEW SUBSECTION, TO BE DESIGNATED SUBSECTION H, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF COMPUTING THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN NURSERY SCHOOLS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLAION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title II, Chapter 5, Section 2, Subsection A of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
 2-5-2: (A)

A "Family Care Home" is any family home in which one (1) or more, but not more than six (6) children under sixteen (16) years of age, not related by blood, adoption or marriage to the persons maintaining the home, are received, cared for and maintained for compensation, or otherwise, for any period of time. Those children, under nine (9) years of age, related by blood, adoption or marriage to the persons maintaining the home will be included in the total number of six (6). The license issued shall specify the number of children to be received and cared for, excluding the Family Care Home mother's own children. Children of school age who are being cared for by the licensee will count in the total number of daytime children. A Family Care Home license may authorize child care on a twenty-four (24) hour basis, or on a daytime basis only, or both, and the number of children which may be received and cared for at one time shall not exceed the number specified in the license. Not more than two (2) children in a Family Care Home may be infants under the age of two (2) years.
