

ORDINANCE NO. 1414

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ADOPT TITLE VI, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 34, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, PROVIDING THAT AN OFFENSE MADE A MISDEMEANOR BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA SHALL ALSO BE A MISDEMEANOR IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS WHENEVER SUCH OFFENSE IS COMMITTED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Nevada, by virtue of Chapter 2, Section 31, Subsection 77, of the Las Vegas City Charter, has granted to the Board of Commissioners of said City the power to declare by ordinance that any offense made a misdemeanor by the laws of the State of Nevada shall also be deemed to be a misdemeanor in the City of Las Vegas whenever such offense is committed within the boundaries of said City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of said City has exercised such power, such ordinance to be found in Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, of the Municipal Code of said City; and

WHEREAS, many new criminal laws were enacted by the 1969 Session of the Nevada Legislature, which laws become effective July 1, 1969; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of said City desire by this ordinance to re-adopt said Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, to include within its purview all of such laws which become effective on July 1, 1969;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, is hereby re-adopted and amended to read as follows:

6-1-34 STATE MISDEMEANORS: The commission of any act within the corporate limits of the City, or the failure to perform any act within such corporate limits, which is made a misdemeanor by the laws of the State of Nevada in effect on, or becoming effective upon, the first day of July, 1969, is hereby declared to be and shall constitute a misdemeanor.


