ORDINANCE NO. 2128

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY AMENDING SECTION 7107 OF THAT CERTAIN DOCUMENT ADOPTED BY REFERENCE BY SAID SECTION 1 AND ENTITLED "SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENT," ADOPTED BY REFERENCE, COMPLETING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, CONTAINED IN TITLE IV OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE BY MODIFYING, AMENDING, ADDING TO OR DELETING FROM CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1979 EDITION TO PERMIT THE USE OF BARBED WIRE FENCING AROUND TOWNHOUSE AND CONDOMINIUM DEVELOPMENTS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Permits the use of barbed wire in security fencing six feet or more above grade or ground in townhouse and condominium developments.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 7107 of that certain document entitled "Supplemental Document, Adopted by Reference, Completing the Uniform Building Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, Contained in Title IV of the Municipal Code by Modifying, Amending, Adding to or Deleting From Certain Sections of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition" and adopted by reference by Title IV, Chapter 1, Section 1, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7107.

The following types of fences and walls shall not be installed, maintained or allowed to remain in the City:

- (a) A fence with sharp pointed pickets, posts or stakes of which the top of the point is less than three-quarters (3/4) of an inch in its

1 least dimension.

2 (b) A fence with electrified apparatus either alter-
3 nating or direct current or any static device
4 producing current.

5 (c) A wall with sharp pieces such as glass, nails,
6 etc., placed or embedded on the top or sides.

7 (d) A fence either entirely or barbed wire and
8 posts or other fencing with barbed wire on top.

9 EXCEPTION: Barbed wire will be allowed as top strands
10 on a security fence around public buildings [and], in
11 commercial and industrial areas and, with the approval
12 of the Planning Commission as to each development,
13 around townhouse and condominium developments; pro-
14 vided, however, that the lower strand is [over] six
15 (6) feet [(6')] from the ground.] or more above grade
16 or the adjacent ground level.

17 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
18 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any
19 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or
20 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
21 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
22 the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
23 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares
24 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
25 paragraphs, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of
26 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
27 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
28 tional, invalid or ineffective.

29 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
30 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
31 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada

1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
