THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title IV, Chapter 1, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding to that certain document incorporated in said Title and Chapter by Section 2 thereof and entitled "A Supplemental Document, Adopted by Reference, Completing the Building Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, Contained in Title IV of the Municipal Code, by Modifying, Amending, Adding to or Deleting from Certain Sections of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition," a new section, to be designated as Section 26, reading as follows:

SECTION 26: Section 1709(a) of the Uniform Building Code is hereby amended by adding thereto an Exception 5 to read as follows:

5. Two-hour area separation walls which terminate at the underside of roof sheathing, provided that the roof has at least one-hour fire-resistive time period for a width of not less than 5 feet on each side of the area separation wall termination.

1 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
3 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
4 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such de-
5 cision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
6 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
7 Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
8 hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection,
9 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,
10 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
11 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
12 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
14 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
16 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

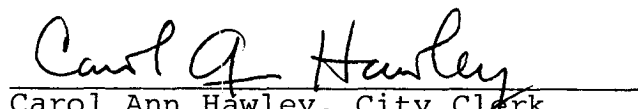
