8 SECTION 5, INCLUDING WITHIN THE PRIVILEGED BUSINESSES TO WHICH  
9 SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER PERTAIN THE LICENSING CATEGORY OF "LOCK-  
10 SMITH"; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND  
11 REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT  
12 HEREWITH.

18 THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,  
19 NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Chapter 10 of Title V of the Municipal Code  
21 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, as added to said  
22 Title by Ordinance No. 2246 of said City, is hereby amended by  
23 adding thereto a new Section, to be designated as Section 5,  
24 reading as follows:

25 5-10-5: (A) No person shall engage in the business of a lock-  
26 smith or a safe mechanic without first obtaining  
27 and thereafter maintaining a valid, unexpired  
28 license pursuant to this Code.

29 (B) Each employee of a locksmith or a safe mechanic,  
30 other than one who is required to be found suitable,  
31 who performs the function of a locksmith or a safe  
32 mechanic, as defined in Chapter 655 of the Nevada  
Revised Statutes, must first obtain and thereafter  
maintain a valid, unexpired work card pursuant to  
Chapter 46 of Title V of this Code.

(C) Each person who is required to be licensed by this  
section must pay in advance a semi-annual license  
fee of \$50.00.

1 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,  
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part  
3 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid  
4 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such de-  
5 cision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the  
6 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board  
7 of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
8 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
9 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespec-  
10 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,  
11 subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared  
12 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


13 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,  
14 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
16 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

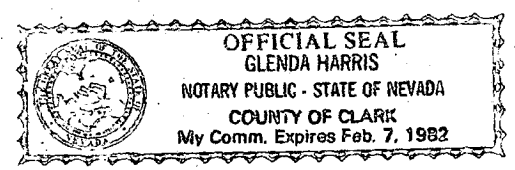

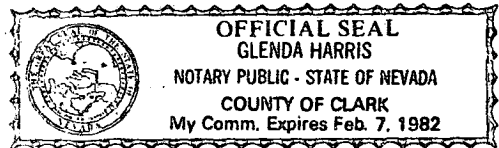
