ORDINANCE NO. 5251

AN ORDINANCE TO BRING THE CITY'S CHILD CARE PROVISIONS REGARDING ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES INTO CONFORMANCE WITH STATE REGULATIONS ON THE SUBJECT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Amends the City's child care provisions regarding accommodation facilities to bring them into conformance with State regulations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 24, Section 380, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.24.380: (A) No accommodation facility shall:

(1) Provide care for any child for more than three and one-half hours in any twenty-four-hour period; [or]

(2) Serve food, other than what is provided by the parent or guardian, to any child in its care[.] ; or

(3) Administer medication to any child in its care.

(B) At least one adult who is in any way responsible for placing a child in the care of an accommodation facility shall, at all times during which the child is in the care of the accommodation facility, remain on the premises of the establishment that operates the accommodation facility.

(C) When a person places a child in the care of an accommodation facility, the person in charge of the accommodation facility shall inform the person placing the child of the requirements of this Section.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. 1 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
3 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
4 invalid or ineffective.

5 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared
6 to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is
7 required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
8 misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
9 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
10 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such
11 fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

12 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
13 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
14 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

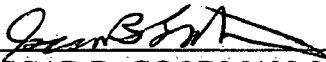

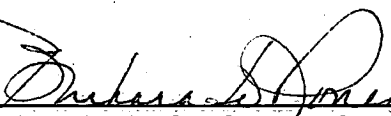

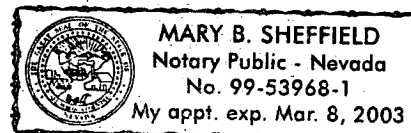
