3 AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY, TO PARTICULARLY
4 DESCRIBE THE LAND TO BE ANNEXED, TO MAKE ITS INHABITANTS SUBJECT TO THE
5 LAWS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED
6 MATTERS. (A-50-99(A))

Summary: Annexes property described generally
as located on the southeast corner of Shaumber
Road and Red Coach Avenue.

10 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
11 AS FOLLOWS:

12 SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, are hereby
13 extended to include, annex to, and make a part of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, the following
14 described real property, to-wit:

15 The West Half (W 1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter
16 (SE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range
17 59 East, M.D.M., in the County of Clark, State of Nevada.

18 SECTION 2: That said City Council has determined and does hereby determine, that
19 said described territory meets the requirements provided by law for annexation to the City of Las
20 Vegas for the following reasons:

- 21 A. The area to be annexed was contiguous to the City's boundaries at the time the
22 annexation proceedings were instituted;
- 23 B. More than one-eighth (1/8) of the aggregate external boundaries of the area are
24 contiguous to the City of Las Vegas;
- 25 C. The territory proposed to be annexed is not included within the boundaries of
26 another incorporated city or within the boundaries of any unincorporated town
27 as those boundaries existed as of July 1, 1983;
- 28 D. The City of Las Vegas is eligible to annex the area described in this report
since the landowners have signed a petition constituting one hundred percent
(100%) of the owners of record of individual lots or parcels of land within the
annexation area.

1 SECTION 3: The City of Las Vegas will provide police protection through the Las
2 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, fire protection, street maintenance, and library services
3 immediately upon annexation. Garbage collection by the company franchised by the City will also
4 be provided immediately. The City sanitary sewer system will serve the proposed annexation area.
5 Any connection to or extension of this sewer line to serve the annexation area shall be at the expense
6 of the landowners. Other services, such as participation in the City's recreational programs, special
7 education classes and programs, public works planning, building inspections, and other City services
8 will also be available immediately. Utilities such as gas, electricity, telephone, and water are provided
9 by private utility companies and other services to the area will not be affected by annexation. Street
10 paving, curbs and gutters, sidewalks and street lights which are not in place at the time of annexation
11 will be installed in the presently developed areas upon the request of the property owners and at their
12 expense by means of special assessment districts. Such improvements will be extended into the
13 undeveloped areas as development takes place and the need therefor arises, and will be located
14 according to the needs of the area at that time. Such installations will also be made at the expense of
15 the property owners, either by means of special assessment districts or as prerequisites to the approval
16 of subdivision plats, building permits or other land use or development applications.

17 SECTION 4: The annexation of said described territory shall become effective on the
18 30th day of June, 2000, and on such date the City of Las Vegas will have the funds appropriated in
19 sufficient amount to finance the extension into said described territory of police protection, fire
20 protection, street maintenance, street sweeping, and street lighting maintenance.

21 SECTION 5: Said described territory, together with the inhabitants and property
22 thereof, shall, from and after the 30th day of June, 2000, be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances and
23 regulations in force in the City of Las Vegas and shall be entitled to the same privileges and benefits
24 as other parts of said City, and shall be subject to municipal taxes levied by the City of Las Vegas,
25 Nevada.

26 SECTION 6: The City Engineer of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is hereby instructed
27 to cause to be prepared an accurate map or plat of said described territory and to record the same,
28 together with a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the County Recorder of Clark County,

1 Nevada, which said recording shall be done prior to the 30th day of June, 2000.

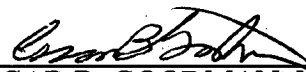
2 SECTION 7: The said described territory, which heretofore has been zoned R-U
3 (County of Clark classification), is hereby classified as U (SC) (City of Las Vegas classification),
4 which is deemed to be the City equivalent of said County classification.

5 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
6 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid
7 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
8 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
9 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
11 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
12 invalid or ineffective.

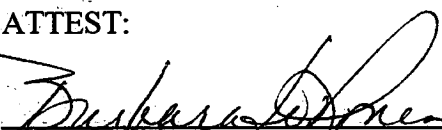
13 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases,
