ORDINANCE NO. 5212

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL TO WAIVE THE APPLICATION FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS.

Summary: Authorizes the City Council to waive the application fee for residential parking permits.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 65, Section 60, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.65.060: (A) Except as otherwise provided in this Section. [Each applicant filing] each person who applies for a residential parking permit pursuant to LVMC 11.65.050 shall be charged a fee of twenty dollars to cover the administrative costs of permits, studies and signing of the zone. The fee shall entitle the applicant to a maximum of three residential parking permits for vehicles housed at the residence of the applicant and two visitor parking placards.

(B) Upon presentation of adequate proof, persons sixty-five years of age or older[,] who otherwise qualify for the permit[,] shall be exempt from paying the application fee.

(C) The City Council may waive the application fee in other particular cases for good cause shown and in the public interest.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,

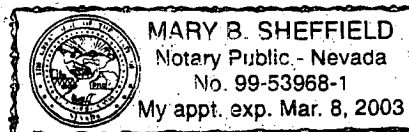

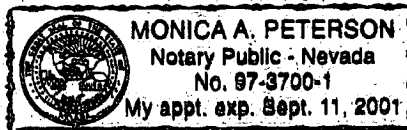
