ORDINANCE NO. 5222

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO DELEGATE TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO REVISE THE CITY'S PERSONNEL POLICIES MANUAL.

Summary: Delegates to the City Manager the authority to revise the City's Personnel Policies Manual.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 3, Chapter 8, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.08.010: That certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, and designated as "Personnel Policies Manual, 1997 Edition," is hereby adopted and by this reference is made a part of this Code, to the same effect as if set out in full herein. The City Manager is authorized to revise the Manual, in whole or in part and from time to time as the need arises. Any revision shall indicate the fact of City Manager approval and the approval date or effective date, and shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
