**ORDINANCE NO. 5156**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 26, SECTIONS 30 AND 35, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE JUDGES OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT AND TO ELIMINATE THE STIPEND FOR THE MASTER JUDGE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Increases the salaries of the Municipal Court Judges and eliminates the stipend for the Master Judge.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**2.26.030:** (A) Except as is otherwise provided in [Subsection (B) of this Section and] Section 2.26.035, the salary of each Municipal Court Judge shall be [eighty-five thousand] ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-three dollars per year, to take effect [January 1, 1996.] July 1, 1999.

(B) The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in years of service in office, either elected or appointed, is the [Master] Chief Judge. [The Master Judge shall be entitled to a three thousand dollar per year stipend due to the additional duties imposed upon him as Master Judge. This stipend shall take effect as of January 1, 1996.]

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 35, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**2.26.035:** The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges that are provided for in Section 2.26.030 shall automatically be increased:

(A) On the first day of July, [1996,] 2000, in the same proportion that the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department of Labor, for March of [1996] 2000 has increased above such index figure for March of [1995:] 2000;


2 (B) On the first day of July in each year thereafter in the same proportion that such  
3 index figure for March of that year has increased above such index figure for March of the previous  
4 year.

5 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or  
6 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid  
7 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or  
8 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the  
9 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,  
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,  
11 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,  
12 invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,  
14 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
15 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



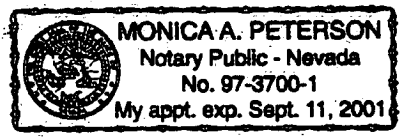

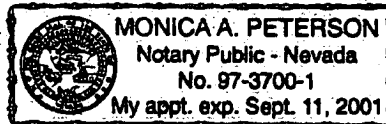
