ORDINANCE NO. 5274

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL TITLE 11, CHAPTER 10, SECTION 190 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE REDUCTION OF PARKING FINES FOR EARLY PAYMENT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Repeals the Municipal Code
provision relating to the reduction of parking
fines for early payment.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 130, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.10.130: Wherever in this Title any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor or wherever in this Title the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, the sanction therefor is civil in nature in the monetary amount which is set forth in Sections 11.10.150 to [11.10.190,] 11.10.180, inclusive.

SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.10.140: (A) The schedule of civil fines which is contained in Sections 11.10.150 to [11.10.190,] 11.10.180, inclusive, is established for infractions of the parking laws and regulations which are set forth in this Code.

(B) The owner and/or operator shall be liable for an additional collection fee where the collection of the fines and penalties provided for herein are referred for collection to a private collection agency. The amount of such fee shall be twenty-five percent of the outstanding indebtedness or two hundred fifty dollars, whichever is less. Upon application of the Las Vegas City Attorney's office, a judgment or amended judgment entered under this Title shall include the fee provided for in this provision.

(C) When a notice of nonpayment of a civil fine imposed under this Chapter has been filed with the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety pursuant to NRS 484.444, the



1 City is authorized to charge the party liable an administrative fee of ten dollars to cover the costs of
2 the filing, handling and release of the notice of nonpayment. The administrative fee shall be paid at
3 the time the fine is collected and the release authorized.

4 SECTION 3: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 190, of the Municipal Code of the City of
5 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

6 SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
7 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid
8 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
9 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
10 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
11 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
12 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
13 invalid or ineffective.

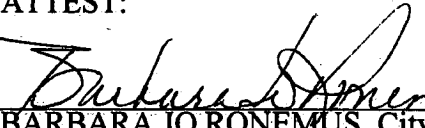
14 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
