ORDINANCE NO. 5340

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION OR MANUFACTURE OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA IN VIOLATION OF STATE LAW, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Prohibits the sale, distribution or manufacture of drug paraphernalia in violation of State law.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Title 10 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter, consisting of the provision set forth as Section 2 of this Ordinance:

SECTION 2: Any person who delivers or sells, possesses with the intent to deliver or sell, or manufactures with the intent to deliver or sell any drug paraphernalia, knowing, or under circumstances where one reasonably should know, that it will be used to plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, conceal, inject, ingest, inhale or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance in violation of NRS Chapter 453 is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. 4 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

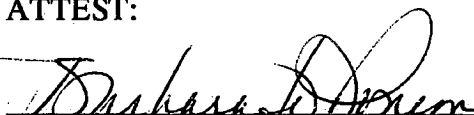
5 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases,

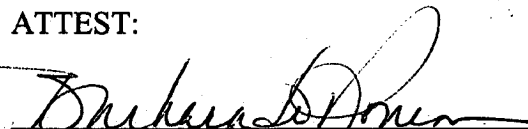

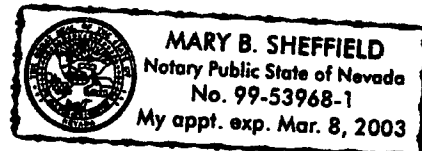
