Ordinance No. 3133

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ABATEMENT OF LITTER; AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 100, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO DESIGNATE THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING AND SAFETY AS THE PERSON WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING CORRECTIVE ACTION UNDER THE CITY'S LITTER ABATEMENT ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Designates Director of Building and Safety as person responsible for enforcement of City's litter abatement ordinance.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 9, Chapter 12, Section 100, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.12.100 In the event the owner fails to comply with the order and correct the conditions specified therein, the Director of [Engineering Services] Building and Safety is authorized and empowered to cause or employ City personnel and equipment or other persons and equipment to enter upon the premises and correct the offending condition. The actual costs thereof shall be charged against the owner. Where the full amount due the City is not paid by such owner within sixty days after the disposal of such litter, as provided for in Sections 9.12.080 and 9.12.090, then, and in that case, the Director of [Engineering Services] Building and Safety shall cause to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder a sworn statement by the Director of [Engineering Services] Building and Safety showing the cost and expense incurred for the work, the date the work was

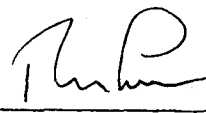
1 done and the location of the property on which said
2 work was done. The recordation of such sworn statement
3 shall constitute a lien and privilege on the property,
4 and shall remain in full force and effect for the amount
5 due in principal and interest, accrued at the rate of
6 six percent per year, plus costs of court, if any,
7 for collection, until final payment has been made.

8 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
10 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
11 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such de-
12 cision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
13 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City
14 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that
15 it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
16 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
17 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
18 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
19 tional, invalid or ineffective.

20 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
21 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
22 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
23 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

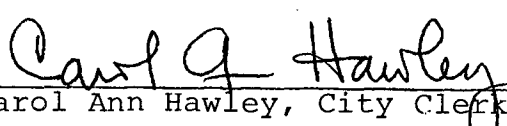

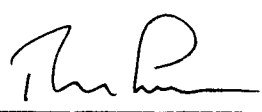

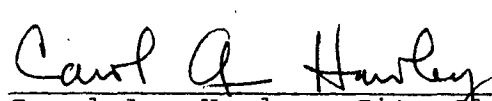
