Ordinance No. 3134

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS; AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 40, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO DESIGNATE THE DIRECTOR OF BUILDING AND SAFETY AS THE "DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE CITY'S DANGEROUS BUILDINGS CODE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Designates Director of Building and Safety as "Director of Public Works" for purposes of enforcement of City's Dangerous Buildings Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 16, Chapter 8, Section 40, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.08.040: The Director of the Department of [Public Services,] Building and Safety, or his authorized representative, is designated as the Director of Public Works whenever such is referred to in the Dangerous Buildings Code.

SECTION 2: Title 16, Chapter 8, section 50, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,

1 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
2 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
3 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
4 tional, invalid or ineffective.

5 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
6 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
7 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
8 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

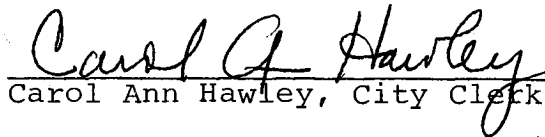
