AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSING LAWS AND REGULATIONS; AMENDING TITLE 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER, DESIGNATED AS CHAPTER 78, PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PRODUCERS OR PROMOTERS OF SPECIAL EVENTS, ESTABLISHING A LICENSE FEE AND REQUIRING EVIDENCE OF ANY PRIZES OFFERED FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Requires producers or promoters of special events to obtain a business license and to furnish evidence of all prizes at least a month before the event.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter, designated as Chapter 78, and consisting of Sections 6.78.010 to 6.78.040, inclusive, reading as follows:

6.78.010: Unless the context requires otherwise, the following definitions apply to this Chapter:

(A) "Producer or promoter" means any person who is directly or indirectly responsible for the organization of a special event and who directly or indirectly receives admission or entrance fees paid by participants or spectators.

(B) "Special event" includes sporting events, entertainments, and similar activities, not otherwise regulated by this Code, which are not offered on a continuous basis, for which members of the public pay an admission or entrance fee to be spectators or participants.

. . . .

1 6.78.020: No person shall act as a producer or promoter of special
2 events without first obtaining a valid unexpired
3 license pursuant to this Code.

4 6.78.030: Each licensee shall pay in advance a license fee of
5 fifty dollars per special event.

6 6.78.040: If one or more prizes will be offered to participants
7 in a special event, the licensee must provide to the
8 Department at least one month before the special event
9 satisfactory proof that the prizes for the event are
10 or will be available to be awarded at the conclusion
11 of the event. This proof will include but not be
12 limited to the prizes themselves, contracts or other
13 enforceable agreements for the prizes, or a surety
14 bond in an amount equal to any cash prizes offered
15 for the event. Such bond must be maintained until the
16 prizes offered for the event have been awarded, and
17 the surety must be acceptable to and approved by the
18 City Attorney. Such bond must be conditioned to be
19 paid to the City or to any person who suffers any
20 damage by reason of the licensee's failure to award
21 cash prizes as advertised before the special event.

22 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
23 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
24 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional
25 or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
26 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
27 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.

28 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares
29 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
30 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of
31 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
32 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-

1 tional, invalid or ineffective.

2 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
3 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
4 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
5 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

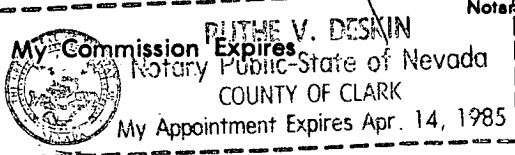
