10 OTHER PERMITS TO OBTAIN SPECIFIED INSURANCE COVERAGE; BY ADDING
11 TO SAID CHAPTER A NEW SECTION, DESIGNATED AS SECTION 50, REQUIRING
12 APPLICANTS FOR FILMING PERMITS TO OBTAIN EITHER SPECIFIED INSUR-
ANCE COVERAGE OR AN INDEMNITY BOND; BY ADDING TO SAID CHAPTER
NEW SECTIONS, DESIGNATED AS SECTION 70 AND SECTION 80, REQUIRING
APPLICANTS FOR PERMITS UNDER SAID CHAPTER TO EMPLOY NECESSARY
POLICE PROTECTION AND TO PAY ADDITIONAL COSTS INCURRED BY THE
CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND THE LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT
IN CONNECTION WITH PARADES AND OTHER SPECIAL EVENTS; PROVIDING
FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES
OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

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18 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,
19 DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 56, Section 10 of the
21 Municipal Code, of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 11.56.010: No [funeral,] procession, parade, running or bicycle
24 marathon or similar event [or parade, excepting the
25 forces of the United States Army, Air Force, Marines
26 or Navy, the military forces of this State, and the
27 forces of the Metropolitan Police and Fire Services
28 Departments,] may occupy, march or proceed along any
29 street or right-of-way except in accordance with a
30 permit issued by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police
31 Department and approved by the City Manager and such
32 other regulations [as are] set forth herein which may

1 apply. This requirement does not apply to the forces
2 of the United States Army, Air Force, Marines and Navy,
3 the military forces of this State, and the forces of
4 the Metropolitan Police and Fire Services Departments.

5 SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 56, Section 20 of the
6 Municipal Code, of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 11.56.020: No driver of a vehicle may drive between the vehicles
9 or persons which comprise an [funeral or other] autho-
10 rized procession or parade while it is in motion [and
11 when such vehicles or persons are conspicuously desig-
12 nated as required in this Chapter]. This provision
13 shall not apply at intersections where traffic is
14 controlled by traffic signals or Police Officers, nor
15 shall it apply to the drivers of authorized emergency
16 vehicles when such drivers are responding to an emer-
17 gency.

18 SECTION 3: Title 11, Chapter 56, Section 30 of
19 the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
20 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

21 SECTION 4: Title 11, Chapter 56, of the Municipal
22 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby
23 amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section
24 30, reading as follows:

25 11.56.030: No permit required under LVMC §11.56.010 shall be
26 issued before the applicant provides satisfactory
27 proof of securing a comprehensive general liability
28 insurance policy that names the City of Las Vegas and
29 the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department as
30 additional insureds. This policy shall be issued by
31 an insurance company authorized to do business in
32 Nevada with coverage designated for the premises where

1 the permitted activity will take place, including any
2 public property, facility or right of way belonging to
3 the City of Las Vegas. The policy limits of such
4 insurance shall not be less than the following:

5 Property damage \$25,000 each occurrence
6 Bodily injury or death. . \$100,000 each person
7 \$300,000 each occurrence

8 SECTION 5: Title 11, Chapter 56, of the Municipal
9 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby
10 amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 50,
11 reading as follows:

12 11.56.050: No permit required under LVMC §11.56.040 shall be
13 issued before the applicant provides satisfactory
14 proof of securing one of the following:

15 (A) A comprehensive general liability insurance policy,
16 issued by an insurance company authorized to do business
17 in Nevada with coverage designated for the premises
18 where the permitted activity will take place, including
19 any public property, facility or right of way belonging
20 to the City of Las Vegas. Such policy shall name the
21 City of Las Vegas and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police
22 Department as additional insureds. The policy limits
23 of such insurance shall be not less than the following:

24 Property damage \$100,000 each occurrence
25 Bodily injury or death. . \$500,000 each person
26 \$1,000,000 each occurrence

27 (B) A comprehensive indemnity bond issued by a surety
28 authorized to do business in Nevada. The indemnity
29 bond shall indemnify the City of Las Vegas and the
30 Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department against
31 liability for all claims for damage to property or
32 injury to or death of persons arising out of or

1 resulting from the conduct of the motion picture or
2 television production. The bond limits shall not
3 be less than the following:
4 Property damage \$100,000 each occurrence
5 Bodily injury or death. . \$500,000 each person
6 \$1,000,000 each occurrence

7 SECTION 6: Title 11, Chapter 56, of the Municipal
8 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby
9 amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 70,
10 reading as follows:

11 11.56.070: Every permittee under this Chapter shall employ, at
12 its own expense, police protection where such protection
13 is found necessary for the public safety and the pro-
14 tection of public property by the sheriff of the Las
15 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. The number and
16 type of officers shall be determined and specified by
17 the sheriff of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Depart-
18 ment to provide for the preservation of order and pro-
19 tection of property in and around the premises where
20 the activity for which a permit is issued is to be
21 conducted.

22 SECTION 7: Title 11, Chapter 56, of the Municipal
23 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby
24 amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section
25 80, reading as follows:

26 11.56.080: Permittees under this Chapter shall pay any additional
27 costs incurred by the City of Las Vegas or the Las
28 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department as a direct result
29 of the activity for which a permit is issued. The
30 additional costs for which permittees shall be respon-
31 sible shall include but not be limited to personnel
32 and equipment expenditures associated with preparing
