THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, are hereby extended to include, annex to, and make a part of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, the following described real property, to-wit:

Those portions of Sections 22, 27 and 28, Township 20 South, Range 60 East, M.D.M., in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, described as follows:

PARCEL 1

The West Half (W 1/2) of said Section 22.

PARCEL 2

The West Half (W 1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of said Section 22.

PARCEL 3

The South Half (S 1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 27.

PARCEL 4

The Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 27.

. . . .

1 PARCEL 5

2 The Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter
3 (NW 1/4) of said Section 27.

4 PARCEL 6

5 The North Half (N 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4)

7 PARCEL 7

9 (SE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said

11 PARCEL 8

12 The North Half (N 1/2) of said Section 28.

13 SECTION 2: That said City Council has determined and
14 does hereby determine, that said described territory meets the
15 requirements provided by law for annexation to the City of Las
16 Vegas for the following reasons:

17 A. The area to be annexed was contiguous to the
18 City's boundaries at the time the annexation pro-
19 ceedings were instituted;

20 B. More than one-eighth (1/8) of the aggregate
21 external boundaries of the area are contiguous
22 to the City of Las Vegas;

23 C. The territory proposed to be annexed is not
24 included within the boundaries of another incor-
25 porated city or within the boundaries of any unin-
26 corporated town as those boundaries existed as of
27 July 1, 1983;

28 D. The City of Las Vegas is eligible to annex
29 the area described in this report since the
30 owners of record of not less than 75 percent of
31 the individual lots or parcels of land within
32 the annexation area have signed a petition
33 requesting annexation to the City.

SECTION 3: The City of Las Vegas will provide police

1 protection through the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department,
2 fire protection, street maintenance, and library services
3 immediately upon annexation. Garbage collection by the company
4 franchised by the City will also be provided immediately. The
5 City sanitary sewer system will serve the proposed annexation
6 area. Any connection to or extension of this sewer line to serve
7 the annexation area shall be at the expense of the landowners.
8 Other services, such as participation in the City's recreational
9 programs, special educational classes and programs, public works
10 planning, building inspections, and other City Hall services
11 will also be available immediately. Utilities such as gas,
12 electricity, telephone, and water are provided by private utility
13 companies and other services to the area will not be affected by
14 annexation. Street paving, curbs and gutters, sidewalks and
15 street lights which are not in place at the time of annexation
16 will be installed in the presently developed areas upon the
17 request of the property owners and at their expense by means
18 of special assessment districts. Such improvements will be
19 extended into the undeveloped areas as development takes place
20 and the need therefor arises, and will be located according to
21 the needs of the area at that time. Such installations will
22 also be made at the expense of the property owners, either by
23 means of special assessment districts or as prerequisites to the
24 approval of subdivision plats or the issuance of building permits,
25 re-zonings, zone variances or special use permits.

26 SECTION 4: The annexation of said described territory
27 shall become effective on the 7th day of November, 1984, and on
28 such date the City of Las Vegas will have the funds appropriated
29 in sufficient amount to finance the extension into said described
30 territory of police protection, fire protection, street maintenance,
31 street sweeping, and street lighting maintenance.

32 SECTION 5: Said described territory, together with the

1 inhabitants and property thereof, shall, from and after the 7th
2 day of November, 1984, be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances
3 and regulations in force in the City of Las Vegas and shall be
4 entitled to the same privileges and benefits as other parts of
5 said City, and shall be subject to municipal taxes levied by the
6 City of Las Vegas, Nevada.

7 SECTION 6: The City Engineer of the City of Las Vegas,
8 Nevada, is hereby instructed to cause to be prepared an accurate
9 map or plat of said described territory and to record the same,
10 together with a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of
11 the County Recorder of Clark County, Nevada, which said recording
12 shall be done prior to the 7th day of November, 1984.

13 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
14 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any
15 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or
16 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
17 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
18 the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
19 City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it
20 would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, para-
21 graph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the
22 fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
23 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
24 tional, invalid or ineffective.
