3 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSING LAWS AND REGULATIONS;

6 6, CHAPTER 22 OF SAID CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION,

8 CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS BY TELEPHONE IDENTIFY THEMSELVES IN THE
9 FIRST THIRTY SECONDS OF ANY SOLICITATION; PROVIDING FOR OTHER
10 MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS

12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
13 HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 22, Section 150 of the
15 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby
16 repealed in its entirety.

17 SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 22, of the Municipal Code
18 of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by
19 adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 150, reading
20 as follows:

21 6.22.150: Within the first thirty seconds of any solicitation
22 by telephone, the person making the solicitation must
23 identify himself by his full name, his business affili-
24 ation (if he is a professional promoter) and the name
25 of the charitable organization on whose behalf the
26 solicitation is being made.

27 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
28 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
29 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
30 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
31 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
32 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.

1 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares
2 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
3 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of
4 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
5 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
6 tional, invalid or ineffective.

7 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
8 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
9 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
10 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
