Ordinance No. 3321

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COMMISSIONS, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3307 OF SAID CITY; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 44, SECTION 20, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL BE LIMITED TO TWO SUCCESSIVE TERMS AND, THEREAFTER, SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT TO A FURTHER TERM ON SAID COMMISSION UNTIL TWO YEARS HAVE ELAPSED FOLLOWING THE EXPIRATION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE CURRENT OR MOST RECENT TERMS; AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 4, OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION TO PROVIDE A SIMILAR LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF SUCCESSIVE TERMS THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF CIVIL SERVICE TRUSTEES MAY SERVE; AMENDING TITLE 19, CHAPTER 94, SECTION 10, OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE A SIMILAR LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF SUCCESSIVE TERMS THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT MAY SERVE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Limits the number of successive terms that the members of the Planning Commission, the Board of Civil Service Trustees and the Board of Zoning Adjustment may serve.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 3307 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 44, Section 20, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.44.020: (A) The term of each appointed member shall be four years or until his successor takes office, except that the terms of the first three members appointed after August 1, 1981, shall be one, two and two years, respectively.

(B) No incumbent member or former member who has served at least two consecutive full four year terms shall be eligible for appointment to a

1 further term until at least two years have elapsed
2 since the expiration of his or her current term or
3 most recent term, as the case may be.

4 (C) Members may be removed after a public hearing, by a
5 majority vote of the City Council, for inef-
6 ficiency, neglect of duty[,] or malfeasance in
7 office.

8 ~~[(C)]~~ (D) Vacancies occurring otherwise than through
9 the expiration of a term shall be filled for the
10 unexpired term.

11 SECTION 3: Title 3, Chapter 4, of the Municipal Code
12 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
13 by adding thereto the provision that is set forth as Section 4
14 of this Ordinance.

15 SECTION 4: No incumbent member or former member of the
16 Board of Civil Service Trustees who has served at least two con-
17 secutive full terms shall be eligible for appointment to a
18 further term until at least two years have elapsed since the
19 expiration of his or her current term or most recent term, as the
20 case may be.

21 SECTION 5: Title 19, Chapter 94, Section 10, of the
22 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is
23 hereby amended to read as follows:

24 19.93.010 (A) Pursuant to NRS 278.270, there is hereby created
25 a Board of Zoning Adjustment, consisting of five
26 members. All members of such [board] Board shall
27 be appointed concurrently except that the two mem-
28 bers to be appointed as provided [by this ordinan-
29 cel] in this Section shall be first appointed for
30 terms of one year and two years respectively.
31 Subsequent appointments of all members shall be for
32 five years and shall be so arranged that one will

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expire each year. One member of said Board shall be an appointed member of the Planning Commission of the City.

(B) No incumbent member or former member who has served at least two consecutive full five year terms shall be eligible for appointment to a further term until at least two years have elapsed since the expiration of his or her current term or most recent term, as the case may be.

(C) Members may be removed for inefficiency, neglect of duty[,] or malfeasance of office after a public hearing.

[(C)] (D) Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of any member whose term becomes vacant.

SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
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1 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
2 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
