5 **THEREOF, UNTIL DATE OF PAYMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS**

9 Summary: Increases interest charged for late
10 payment of room tax from one to one and one-
11 half percent per month, or fraction thereof,

13 **THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN**
14 **AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 46, Section 70, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las**
16 **Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:**

17 **6.46.070: Notwithstanding anything in Title 6 to the contrary, the tax on room revenues provided for**
18 **by Section 6.46.040 shall be due and payable on the first day of each calendar month next succeeding**
19 **the month during which said revenues accrued. All taxes not paid by the fifteenth day of the month**
20 **in which they are due and payable shall be deemed to be delinquent. The operator shall be assessed**
21 **a penalty of ten percent on all delinquent amounts as well as interest of one and one-half percent per**
22 **month, or fraction thereof, from the first of the month in which such tax becomes due and payable until**
23 **the date of payment.**

24 **SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or**
25 **phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid**
26 **or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or**
27 **effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the**
28 **City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,**
29 **paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,**
30 **subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,**
31 **invalid or ineffective.**

32 **SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,**
33 **sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,**

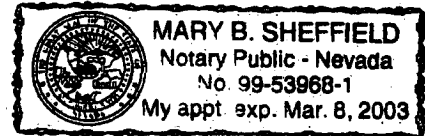

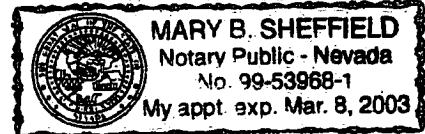
