

ORDINANCE NO. 1863

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IX, CHAPTER 12A, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING A DEFINITION OF DAILY NEWSPAPERS, AND PROVIDING A FORFEITURE FOR LOCATION OF NEWS RACKS IN THE DOWN TOWN AREA; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: 9-12A-1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition is hereby amended as follows:

9-12A-1 Definitions. For purpose of this Ordinance, certain words and phrases shall be construed herein as set forth in this Section, unless it is apparent from the context that a different meaning is intended.

News Rack means any self-service or coin-operated box, containers, storage unit or other dispenser installed, used, or maintained for the displaying or dispensing of newspapers, news periodicals, magazines or other publications.

Street means all that area dedicated to public use for public street purposes and shall include, but not be limited to, roadways, parkways, alleys and sidewalks.

Roadway means that portion of a street improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel.

Parkway means that area between the sidewalks and the curb of any street, and where there is no sidewalk, that area between the edge of the roadway and the property line adjacent thereto. Parkway shall also include any area within a roadway which is not open to vehicular travel.

Sidewalk means any surface provided for the exclusive use of pedestrians.

Daily newspaper means any newspaper printed, published or distributed five or more days each week.

SECTION 2: 9-12A-6(E) is hereby amended as follows:

(E) The order of placement of news racks in Zone A shall be under the direction of the Director of Public Services. If a person requests a designated place to locate a news rack, but thereafter fails to occupy that

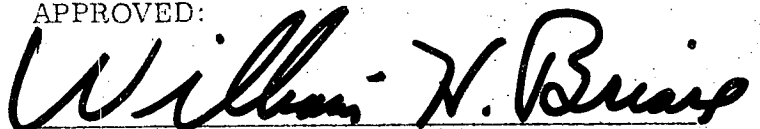
location for a period of fifteen (15) days after notice, then the
Director of Public Services may declare a forfeiture of the desig-
nation and allow other persons to occupy said location with news
racks. Notification shall be deemed complete upon depositing same
with the U. S. mail service using the address supplied to the De-
partment of Public Services by the person securing the location.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

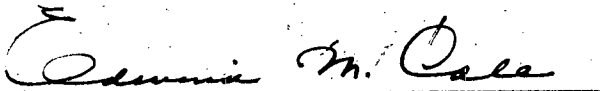

If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.

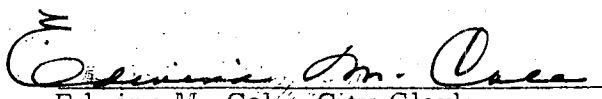
