ORDINANCE NO. 1858

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1795, FIRST AMENDMENT, FIXING SALARIES FOR THE JUDGES OF THE LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURT; TO CONFORM THE FIXING OF THOSE SALARIES WITH THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED, AND TO REPEAL OR AMEND SECTIONS ADOPTED PREVIOUSLY PURSUANT TO SENATE BILL 601, THE CONSOLIDATION LAW, DETERMINED TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL; PROVIDING FOR MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A new Municipal Court in and for the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, to be designated as Department III of the Las Vegas Municipal Courts is hereby created. The municipal judge so appointed by the Board of City Commissioners to fill the Las Vegas Municipal Court Department III, will run for office for a period of four (4) years in the primary and general election to be held in May and June, 1977.

SECTION 2. The salary for the Municipal Court Judge of Department III is hereby fixed at Twenty Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000.00) per annum, for the balance of the appointed period.

SECTION 3. [Beginning on the third day of January, 1977, the salaries of the Municipal Court Judges shall be increased to Twenty Six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000.00) per annum.] Beginning with the terms of office of the Municipal Court Judges elected at the general election in June, 1977, the salary of the municipal Court Judges shall be Twenty Six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000.00) per annum.

SECTION 4. There shall be allotted for each of the Three Departments of the Las Vegas Municipal Court a court bailiff to assist in the operation of the Municipal Court. The bailiffs shall be hired pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Civil Service Board and Personnel Departments of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada; provided, however, that the bailiffs shall be under the direct supervision of the respective Municipal Court Judge of the Department to which they are assigned.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

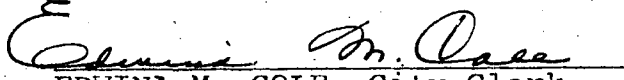

If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word, or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.

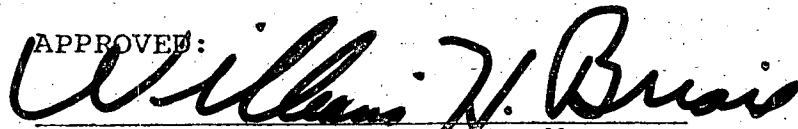

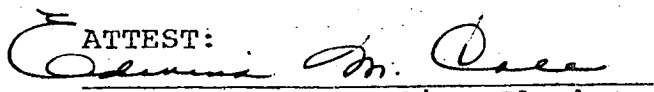
