ORDINANCE NO. 1830

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 18, SECTION 6(D), OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, RELATING TO INVESTIGATION OF CORPORATE APPLICANTS FILING AN APPLICATION FOR A LIQUOR LICENSE WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS BY PROVIDING THAT THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS MAY WAIVE THE REQUIRED INVESTIGATION HEREIN OF ANY OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, LOCAL REPRESENTATIVE OR MANAGING AGENT OF ANY SUCH CORPORATE APPLICANT; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 18, Section 6(D) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-18-6: (D) In the event the applicant shall be a partnership or association each person having an interest therein and each officer, and the local representative or managing agent, whether or not appearing on the license, shall be investigated and the fee for such investigation shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) per person.

In the event the applicant shall be a corporation, each officer and director thereof, and the local representative or managing director, whether or not appearing on the license, shall be investigated and the fee for such investigation shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) per person; provided, however, that in the discretion of the Board of City Commissioners the investigation, and the investigation fee therefor, may be waived with respect to the directors, [only of any such corporation.] or officers, only, of any such corporation, not residing in the State of Nevada and not exercising management control over the applicant(s) local operations.


SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each

section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.
