

ORDINANCE NO. 1824

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 30 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY DELETING THEREFROM ANY AND ALL REFERENCE PERTAINING TO THE TRAFFIC BARRICADING AND CONTROL DEVICES MANUAL, CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, 1972 AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE NEVADA TRAFFIC CONTROL MANUAL, 1976 EDITION AND AMENDING SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 30 OF TITLE X ENTITLED "COPIES FURNISHED" BY DELETING THEREFROM ANY CHARGE FOR A COPY OF THE NEVADA TRAFFIC CONTROL MANUAL; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title X, Chapter 30 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, shall be amended as follows:

10-30-1: That certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, being marked and designated as ["TRAFFIC BARRICADING AND CONTROL DEVICES MANUAL, CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, 1972"] "NEVADA TRAFFIC CONTROL MANUAL, 1976 EDITION", is hereby adopted by reference and said Manual, as the same may hereafter be amended (hereinafter collectively referred to as "The Manual") shall govern the operations of all contractors, subcontractors and/or persons affected by said regulations, who are engaged in work within the corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas.


10-30-2: COPIES FURNISHED: Copies of the Manual shall be furnished to persons requiring copies thereof by the Public Works Department [, at a charge of one dollar fifty cents (\$1.50) per copy.]

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word, or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.



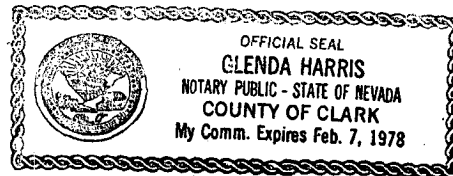

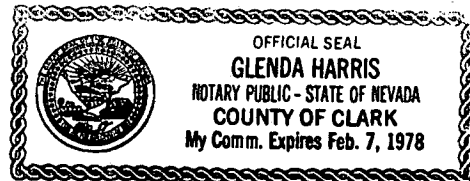
