ORDINANCE NO. 2082

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VIII, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 15, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO ESTABLISH A REVISED SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR COLLECTING, HAULING AND DISPOSING OF GARBAGE IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS EITHER BY SAID CITY OR BY ITS AUTHORIZED CONTRACTOR; TO PROVIDE OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: To provide a new schedule of collecting and disposing of garbage in the City of Las Vegas by the City or by its authorized garbage collection contractor.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title VIII, Chapter 3, Section 15 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8-3-15: (A) Single-family residence. The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and dead animals from single-family residence on a twice-a-week basis, shall be as follows:

[~~\$11.25~~] \$13.84 per quarter, payable in advance, each and every three (3) month period.

(B) Apartments and Multiple Units: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and dead animals from apartments and multiple units on a twice-a-week basis shall be a flat rate to be computed as follows:

[~~\$8.40~~] \$10.33 for the first unit on one stop and [~~\$5.88~~] \$7.23 for each additional unit on one stop, irrespective of occupancy or vacancy of any such additional unit or

1 units, payable each and every three (3)
2 month period. Should six (6) day service
3 be requested by any apartments or multiple
4 units, the rate for service shall be two and
5 one-half (2-1/2) times that for service for
6 a twice-a-week basis.

7 (C) Auto Courts and Mobile Home Parks. The charge for
8 collecting and hauling garbage, rubbish, dirt and
9 dead animals from auto courts and mobile home parks
10 on a twice-a-week basis, shall be as follows:

11 Offices - [~~\$8.40~~] \$10.33 per quarter; Sleeping
12 rooms and mobile homes without cooking faci-
13 lities - [~~\$3.82~~] \$4.70 per quarter; Rooms
14 where cooking facilities are furnished or
15 mobile homes with cooking facilities - [~~\$5.05~~]
16 \$6.21 per quarter; Mobile homes where indi-
17 vidual collections are required - [~~\$8.40~~]
18 \$10.33 per quarter; payable each and every
19 three (3) months, payable in advance, commenc-
20 ing on and continuing on the first day of
21 each and every three (3) months period there-
22 after. Should six (6) day service be requested
23 by any Auto Courts and Mobile Home Parks,
24 the rate for service shall be two and one-half
25 (2-1/2) times that for service for a twice-
26 a-week basis.

27 (D) Hotels, Places of Business and Public Buildings.
28 The quarterly charge for collecting, hauling and
29 disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt, and dead
30 animals from hotels, places of business and public
31 buildings shall be determined by the number and
32 type of receptacles required by each such hotel,

1 place of business or public building and by the
 2 number of daily collections from each per week in
 3 accordance with the following table:

Compacted garbage and refuse shall be billed at the ratio of three to one (3 to 1) in accordance with the size of the container and frequency of service.			
SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

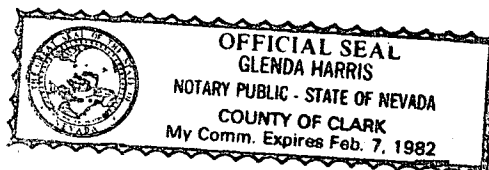

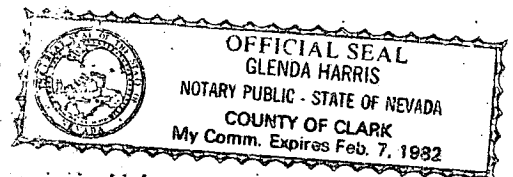
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Summary: To provide a new schedule of collecting and disposing of garbage in the City of Las Vegas by the City or by its authorized collection contractor.
