AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL IN THEIR ENTIRETY CHAPTERS 10.44 AND 11.68 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO SOLICITATION AND TO THE CITY'S PEDESTRIAN MALL, RESPECTIVELY; TO REDESIGNATE CHAPTERS 10.44A AND 11.68A AS CHAPTERS 10.44 AND 11.68, RESPECTIVELY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Repeals Chapters 10.44 and 11.68 of the Municipal Code, relating to solicitation and to the City's Pedestrian Mall, respectively, and redesignates Chapters 10.44A and 11.68A as Chapters 10.44 and 11.68, respectively.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 10, Chapter 44, and Title 11, Chapter 68, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 10, Chapter 44A, and Title 11, Chapter 68A, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, as adopted by Ordinance Nos. 5865 and 5866, respectively, are hereby redesignated as Chapters 10.44 and 11.68, respectively.


SECTION 3: In reflecting the redesignation of Chapters as described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, the codifier is authorized and directed to change throughout the Code any remaining cross-references to Chapters 10.44A and 11.68A (or portions thereof) so that they correctly reflect the redesignations intended by Section 2.


SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
