8 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
9 AS FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 2, Section 70, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
11 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **2.02.070:** [(A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsections (B) and (C) of this Section and
13 Section 2.02.075 of this Chapter, the salary of each member of the City Council is fifteen thousand
14 dollars per year.

15 (B) The salaries of the members of the City Council from Wards 1 and 3 shall each
16 be twenty-five thousand five hundred dollars per year beginning with the term of office that
17 commences following the primary and general elections that will be held in May and June of 1987.

18 (C) The salaries of the members of the City Council from Wards 2 and 4 shall be
19 twenty-five thousand five hundred dollars per year beginning with the term of office that commences
20 following the primary and general elections that will be held in May and June of 1989.] The salaries
21 of the members of the City Council shall be as set forth by ordinance.

22 SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 2, Section 75, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
23 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

24 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 4, Section 20, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
25 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 **2.04.020:** [(A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsection (B) of this Section and Section
27 2.04.030 of this Chapter, the salary of the Mayor is twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars per year.

28 (B) The salary of the Mayor shall be thirty-three thousand five hundred dollars per

1 year beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary and general elections
2 that will be held in May and June of 1987.] The salary of the Mayor shall be as set forth by ordinance.

3 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 4, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
4 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

5 SECTION 5: The annual salary of each member of the City Council, other than the
6 Mayor, shall be \$46,681.44.

7 SECTION 6: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
8 and general elections that will be held in April and June of 2009, the annual salaries of the members
9 of the City Council from Wards 2, 4 and 6 shall each be \$69,237.90.

10 SECTION 7: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
11 and general elections that will be held in April and June of 2011, the annual salaries of the members
12 of the City Council from Wards 1, 3 and 5 shall each be equal to the annual salary of the members of
13 the City Council from Wards 2, 4 and 6, as adjusted pursuant to this Chapter, so that thereafter the
14 salaries of the members from Wards 1 to 6, inclusive, are the same.

15 SECTION 8: (A) Beginning with July 1, 2010, and each July 1 thereafter, the
16 salaries of the members of the City Council that are provided for in Section 6 of this Ordinance shall
17 automatically be increased so that they equal the greater of:

18 (1) Their then-current salaries as increased by the amount that represents
19 the increase in the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for All
20 Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United
21 States Department of Labor, for March of that year over the index figure for March of the preceding
22 year; or

23 (2) Ninety percent of the annual salary that has been established for
24 members of the Clark County Board of Commissioners pursuant to NRS 245.043 to be paid to them
25 as of that July 1.

26 (B) As indicated in Section 7 of this Ordinance, beginning with the term of office
27 that commences following the primary and general elections that will be held in April and June of
28 2011, the annual salaries of the members of the City Council from Wards 1, 3 and 5 shall be adjusted

1 so that thereafter they are the same as the salaries of the members from Wards 2, 4 and 6.

2 SECTION 9: (A) Subject to the provisions of Subsection (B) of this Section, with
3 respect to each member of the City Council, other than the Mayor, the annual salary of such member
4 shall be adjusted on July 1, 2008, and on each July 1 thereafter, in the same proportion that the index
5 figure of the National Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items, U.S. City
6 Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department
7 of Labor, for March of that year has increased above such index figure for March of the preceding
8 year.

9 (B) The provisions of Subsection (A) apply to a member of the City Council only
10 until the provisions of Sections 6 to 8, inclusive, of this Ordinance become applicable with respect to
11 that member.

12 SECTION 10: The salary of the Mayor shall be \$61,327.50.

13 SECTION 11: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
14 and general elections that will be held in May and June of 2011, the annual salary of the Mayor shall
15 be 180 percent of the annual salary established for the other members of the City Council pursuant to
16 this Ordinance.

17 SECTION 12: (A) Beginning with July 1, 2012, and each July 1 thereafter, the
18 salary of the Mayor that is provided for in Section 11 of this Ordinance shall automatically be
19 increased so that it equals the greater of:

20 (1) The Mayor's then-current salary as increased by the amount that
21 represents the increase in the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for all Urban
22 Consumers for All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor
23 Statistics, United States Department of Labor, for March of that year over the index figure for March
24 of the preceding year; or

25 (2) One hundred eighty percent of the annual salary that has been
26 established for the other members of the City Council pursuant to this Ordinance.

27 (B) Until the provisions of Subsection (A) of this Section are applicable, the annual
28 salary of the Mayor shall be adjusted on July 1, 2008, and on each July 1 thereafter, in the same

1 proportion that the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for
2 All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United
3 States Department of Labor, for March of that year has increased above such index figure for March
4 of the preceding year.

5 SECTION 13: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
6 and general elections that will be held in May and June of 2011, the Mayor shall receive a vehicle
7 allowance in the amount of \$600.00 per month.

8 SECTION 14: The salary provisions set forth in Sections 11 and 12 of this Ordinance
9 are established in contemplation that the Mayor will serve on a full-time basis. Therefore, the Mayor
10 may not engage in other employment, either under a contract of employment or as an independent
11 contractor, while serving as Mayor.

12 SECTION 15: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
13 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
14 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
15 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
16 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
17 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
18 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
19 invalid or ineffective.



Summary: Increases the salary of, and provides a vehicle allowance for, the Mayor and City Council.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 2, Section 70, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.02.070: [(A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsections (B) and (C) of this Section and Section 2.02.075 of this Chapter, the salary of each member of the City Council is fifteen thousand dollars per year.

(B) The salaries of the members of the City Council from Wards 1 and 3 shall each be twenty-five thousand five hundred dollars per year beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary and general elections that will be held in May and June of 1987.

(C) The salaries of the members of the City Council from Wards 2 and 4 shall be twenty-five thousand five hundred dollars per year beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary and general elections that will be held in May and June of 1989.] The salaries of the members of the City Council shall be as set forth by ordinance.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 2, Section 75, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 4, Section 20, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.04.020: [(A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsection (B) of this Section and Section 2.04.030 of this Chapter, the salary of the Mayor is twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars per year.

(B) The salary of the Mayor shall be thirty-three thousand five hundred dollars per year beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary and general elections



1 that will be held in May and June of 1987.] The salary of the Mayor shall be as set forth by ordinance.

2 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 4, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
3 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

4 SECTION 5: The annual salary of each member of the City Council, other than the
5 Mayor, shall be \$45,410.

6 SECTION 6: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
7 and general elections that will be held in April and June of 2009, the annual salaries of the members
8 of the City Council from Wards 2, 4 and 6 shall each be \$69,237.90.

9 SECTION 7: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
10 and general elections that will be held in April and June of 2011, the annual salaries of the members
11 of the City Council from Wards 1, 3 and 5 shall each be equal to the annual salary of the members of
12 the City Council from Wards 2, 4 and 6, as adjusted pursuant to this Chapter, so that thereafter the
13 salaries of the members from Wards 1 to 6, inclusive, are the same.

14 SECTION 8: (A) Beginning with July 1, 2010, and each July 1 thereafter, the
15 salaries of the members of the City Council that are provided for in Section 6 of this Ordinance shall
16 automatically be increased so that they equal the greater of:

17 (1) Their then-current salaries as increased by the amount that represents
18 the increase in the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for All

19 increased so that it equals the greater of:

20 (1) The Mayor's then-current salary as increased by the amount that
21 represents the increase in the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for all Urban

5 SECTION 13: (A) Beginning with the term of office that commences following the
6 primary and general elections that will be held in April and June of 2009, the members of the City
7 Council from Wards 2, 4 and 6 shall each receive a vehicle allowance in the amount of \$500 per
8 month.

9 (B) Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary and
10 general elections that will be held in April and June of 2011, the members of the City Council from
11 Wards 1, 3 and 5 shall each receive a vehicle allowance in the amount of \$500 per month.

12 SECTION 14: Beginning with the term of office that commences following the primary
13 and general elections that will be held in May and June of 2011, the Mayor shall receive a vehicle
14 allowance in the amount of \$600.00 per month.

15 SECTION 15: The salary provisions set forth in Sections 11 and 12 of this Ordinance
16 are established in contemplation that the Mayor will serve on a full-time basis. Therefore, the Mayor
17 may not engage in other employment, either under a contract of employment or as an independent
18 contractor, while serving as Mayor.

19 SECTION 16: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
20 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
21 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
22 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
23 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
24 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
25 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
26 invalid or ineffective.
