ORDINANCE NO. 1818

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 32 TO PROHIBIT PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN DENIED A BUSINESS LICENSE WHICH REQUIRES A POLICE INVESTIGATION BY THE LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM REAPPLYING FOR THE SAME LICENSE FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS FOLLOWING THE DENIAL; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

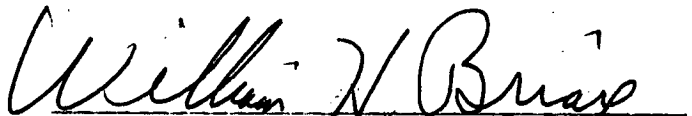
5-1-32 REAPPLICATION FOR BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIRING POLICE INVESTIGATION

Any person, firm, corporation or association applying for a business license or permit pursuant to the terms of any of the provisions of Title V of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, which license or permit requires an investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, may not reapply for the same license for a period of six (6) months immediately following the denial by the Department of License & Revenue.

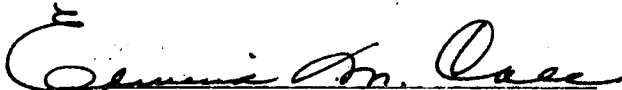
SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

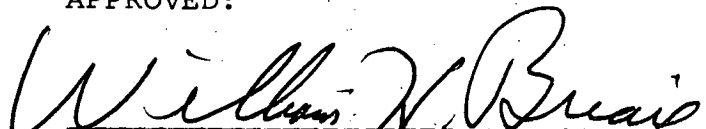

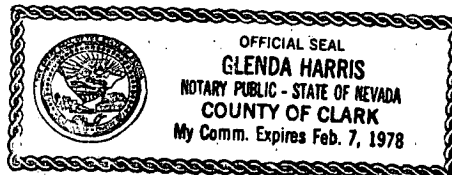

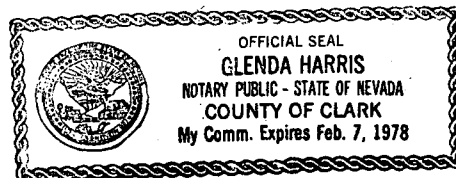
