

ORDINANCE NO. 1809 - FIRST AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE II OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER 12 ENTITLED, "SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD"; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title II of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a new Chapter 12 thereto:

CHAPTER 12

SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD

2-12-1

BOARD CREATED; MEMBERS: There is hereby created a

Senior Citizens' Advisory Board. The Senior Citizens' Advisory Board shall be appointed as follows:

(A) All members shall be appointed by the City Commission.

(B) All members of the Board shall serve for a period of three (3) years, save and except the initial period hereunder. Upon passage hereof and for the initial period hereunder, board members shall be appointed as follows: Four (4) members for a one (1) year term; four (4) members for a two (2) year term and four (4) members for a three (3) year term. Thereafter, all shall serve a three (3) year term.

(C) Vacancies in said Board, occurring by something other than expiration of term, shall be filled by appointment by the Board of City Commissioners for the remainder of the term. The Senior Citizens' Advisory Board may submit to the City Commission their recommendations for appointments and re-appointments to the Advisory Board.

ORGANIZATION: The officers of the Board shall be a

chairman, a vice chairman and a secretary. Within fifteen (15) days after the appointment of the Board, the members shall meet in regular session and select from their members the chairman, vice chairman,

and secretary. The duties of the officers of the Board shall respectively be as are usually carried by such officers. The officers shall hold office for one year, or until their successors are selected.

The Board shall adopt rules and regulations to govern procedures and shall, by vote, set a time for regular meetings which shall be held at least once a month, and shall determine the manner in which special meetings may be called, held, and the notice given. A majority of the regular members shall constitute a quorum for all purposes. Members of the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board must attend seventy-five percent (75%) of all regular meetings, of which they have notice, excluding excused absences. Failure to attend seventy-five percent (75%) of such meeting shall constitute sufficient grounds for the Board of City Commissioners, at its discretion, to remove said member and declare the position vacant. Minutes of the meetings of the Board shall be filed with the City Clerk within thirty (30) days following such meetings.

DUTIES: The duties of the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board shall be:

(A) To act in a recommending capacity, in cooperation with the Senior Citizens' Center Director, to the Board of City Commissioners on all matters pertaining to the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center and to cooperate with other governmental agencies and civic groups in the advance of sound planning for such center.

(B) To recommend to the Board of City Commissioners, in cooperation with the Director of the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center, in writing, as to priorities for all expenditures pertaining to the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center.

(C) To aid in coordinating the services provided by the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center with programs provided by other governmental agencies and other voluntary organizations.

(D) to formulate programs and activities to effectuate the purpose for which the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center was created.

(E) To assist in the functions of the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center Director with the public.

(F) To report their activities annually to the City Manager.


CENTER DIRECTOR TO ATTEND MEETINGS: The Director of the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center shall attend all meetings of the Board and shall serve as an ex-officio officer thereof, but shall have no vote on said Board.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, sub-sections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.



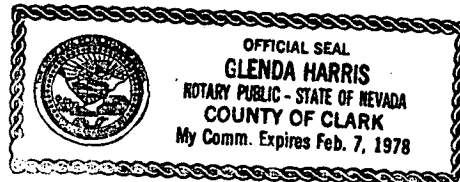
