ORDINANCE NO. 1800

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 28, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY AMENDING SECTION 21 (A) THEREOF TO PROVIDE THAT AMBULANCE ATTENDANTS BE AN AGE OF 18 YEARS OR OVER; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 28, Section 21 (A) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-28-21 A. Be an age of [21] eighteen (18) years or over.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word, or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. Any person, firm, or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.





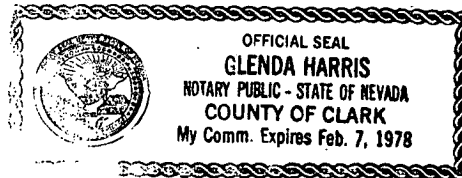
