ORDINANCE NO. 1798

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING A NEW SUB-SECTION C TO PROVIDE THAT UPON THE PROPER NOTICE TO ANY APPLICANT FOR A BUSINESS LICENSE WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, SAID APPLICANT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO APPEAR IN PERSON BEFORE THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED A BUSINESS LICENSE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens, residents and tourists alike of the City of Las Vegas, that any person, upon request, seeking a business license from the City of Las Vegas and the rights and privileges granted thereunder, appear personally before the Board of City Commissioner.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 1, Section 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-1-1 (C) All applicants for a business license seeking to do business within the City of Las Vegas shall appear in person at each City Commission meeting at which the application is being considered. Provided, however, that no applicant shall be required to appear in person unless said applicant has been personally notified to do such or the Department of License and Revenue, five (5) days prior to the meeting at which the application will be considered, has mailed to said applicant at the applicant's address as shown on the application for a business license, a certified or registered letter requesting the applicant's presence at said meeting.

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
If applicant is a corporation the president, any officer, or managing personnel may be required to be personally present upon notice being given as herein provided.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: No action by the Board of City Commissioners or the Department of License and Revenue shall be taken on any application for a business license of any applicant violating the above-stated section.


