

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER 14, CONSISTING OF 4 SECTIONS, REQUIRING THAT THE PRICE OF ADMISSION TO ANY PUBLIC PERFORMANCE, EVENT OR PLACE OF ENTERTAINMENT BE CONSPICUOUSLY PRINTED ON THE TICKET OF ADMISSION THERETO; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT TO SELL TICKETS FOR A PRICE GREATER THAN THAT WHICH IS PRINTED ON THE TICKETS; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SELL TICKETS TO ANY PUBLIC PERFORMANCE, EVENT OR PLACE OF ENTERTAINMENT AT A PRICE GREATER THAN THAT FOR WHICH THE TICKETS ARE SOLD AT ITS BOX OFFICE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas has determined that the price of or charge for admission to places of public entertainment is a matter particularly affected with a public interest, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas has determined that the public has been subjected to certain practices concerning the price of or charge for admissions to places of public entertainment, which practices result in fraud, extortion, exorbitant rates and other similar abuses against the youth, residents and visitors of the City of Las Vegas.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title VI, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 14

TICKET SALES

6-14-1 DEFINITIONS:

(A) Ticket. "Ticket" shall mean any evidence of the right of entry to a place of entertainment.

(B) Place of Entertainment. "Place of Entertainment" shall mean any theater, stadium, auditorium, park or other places where games, contests, exhibitions, amusements or performances are conducted.

(C) Owner. "Owner" shall mean any person, partnership, association or corporation, lessee, manager, trustee, or any of their employees, servants or agents, who own, rent, lease,

control, manage or operate any place of entertainment where tickets are sold for admission thereto.

6-14-2 PRINTING PRICE ON TICKET. Every person, partnership, association or corporation who owns, operates, rents, leases or controls a place of entertainment shall, if a price be charged for admission thereto, conspicuously print on the face of each ticket the price charged therefor by such person, partnership, association or corporation.

6-14-3 SELLING TICKETS FOR MORE THAN PRICE PRINTED ON TICKET. It is unlawful for any person, partnership, association or corporation to sell tickets for admission to a place of entertainment, for a price greater than the price printed upon the face of said ticket and the price of said ticket shall correspond with and be equal to the same price displayed at the office of original distribution thereof and at the box office of or on the premises of such place of entertainment.

6-14-4 SALE OF TICKETS ELSEWHERE THAN AT BOX OFFICE. It is unlawful for any owner to sell or knowingly permit the sale, barter or exchange of any such tickets at any place other than at the ticket office or on the premises of such place of entertainment; but nothing herein shall prevent such owner from distributing such tickets for sale elsewhere at a price no greater than that for which such tickets are sold by such owner at the box office or on the premises of such place of entertainment.


SECTION 2- If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it

would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Any person, firm, corporation or association violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment.




