2 **ORDINANCE NO. 5730**

3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENT TO THE NFPA 1,
4 UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 2003 EDITION, REGARDING THE APPROVAL OF TRAFFIC
5 MANAGEMENT OR CALMING DEVICES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED
6 MATTERS.

9 Summary: Amends the Supplemental Document
10 to the NFPA 1, Uniform Fire Code, 2003
11 Edition, regarding the approval of traffic
12 management or calming devices.

13 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
14 AS FOLLOWS:

15 SECTION 1: The Supplemental Document to the NFPA 1, Uniform Fire Code, 2003
16 Edition, as adopted by Ordinance No. 5667, is hereby amended as set forth in Section 2 of this
17 Ordinance.

18 SECTION 2: Section 18.2.3.1.4, as added to the City's Fire Code by the Supplemental
19 Document, is deleted and a new Section 18.2.3.1.4 is added as follows:

20 **18.2.3.1.4 Traffic Management or Calming Devices.**

21 **18.2.3.1.4.1** The installation and maintenance of traffic management or calming devices within the
22 City is generally governed by City policies and procedures other than this Code. However, in addition
23 and independent of those policies and procedures, the remaining provisions of this Section 18.2.3.1.4
24 shall apply.

25 **18.2.3.1.4.2** Traffic management or calming devices shall not be permitted within the required width
26 of:

- 27 (1) Fire apparatus access roads, including both public and private right of ways; or
28 (2) Primary and Secondary emergency response routes as identified by the Las Vegas Fire
& Rescue.

18.2.3.1.4.3 The Las Vegas Fire & Rescue is authorized to require the removal from any private
property of any existing traffic management or calming device that:

- (1) Does not meet the applicable criteria of the City's Traffic Engineering Division; and
(2) Has been determined by the Las Vegas Fire & Rescue to unnecessarily hinder



1 emergency apparatus response.

2 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
3 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
4 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
5 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
6 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
8 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
9 invalid or ineffective.

10 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
11 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
12 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

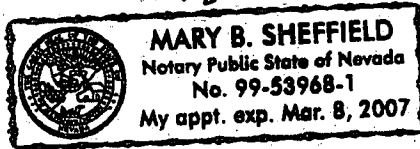
