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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 080 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO INSERT "CITY COUNCIL" IN LIEU OF THE "BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS"; AMENDING CHAPTER 8; SECTION 100 OF SAID TITLE BY MAKING THE SUPERVISOR OF THE ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES REQUIRED UNDER TITLE 7; AMENDING CHAPTER 20, SECTIONS 010, 020, 040 AND 080 OF SAID TITLE TO INSERT "ANIMAL CONTROL CENTER" IN LIEU OF "ANIMAL SHELTER" AND "CITY ANIMAL SHELTER"; AMENDING CHAPTER 24, SECTIONS 040 AND 070 OF SAID TITLE TO INSERT "ANIMAL CONTROL CENTER" IN LIEU OF "CITY ANIMAL SHELTER"; AMENDING CHAPTER 32, SECTION 080, 100, 180 AND 210 OF SAID TITLE TO INSERT "ANIMAL CONTROL CENTER" IN LIEU OF "ANIMAL SHELTER" AND "CITY ANIMAL SHELTER"; AMENDING CHAPTER 40, SECTION 260 OF SAID TITLE TO INSERT "ANIMAL CONTROL CENTER" IN LIEU OF "CITY ANIMAL CENTER"; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Amends the Animal Control ordinance codified as Title 7 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title 7, Chapter 4, Section 080 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.04.080: "Animal Regulation Officer" means the person appointed by the [Board of Commissioners], City Council, his agent, servants, employees, designees or representatives, including any Animal Control Officer authorized to act herein.

SECTION 2. Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 100 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.08.100: Administration. The licensing functions and duties shall be performed by the [Director of the Department of Business Activity] Animal Control Division of the Department of Detention and Correctional Services of the City or [his] its authorized representative.

1 SECTION 3. Title 7, Chapter 20, Section 010 of the
2 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 7.20.010: (A) Every dog or cat found running at large, or in
5 violation of any Section of this Chapter, or without a
6 numbered license tag as required by this Title or any
7 Subsection thereof, shall be impounded by the Animal
8 Regulation Officer at the [Animal Shelter] Animal
9 Control Center and there kept for a period of one
10 hundred twenty hours.

11 (B) If the ownership of the dog or cat is proved
12 within said period of time, the owner shall be able to
13 remove it upon payment of a fine of fifteen dollars for
14 the first imprisonment, thirty dollars for the second
15 such imprisonment within five years, forty-five dollars
16 for the third and subsequent imprisonment within five
17 years, plus five dollars per day for any time over
18 twenty-four hours; said payment shall go to the credit
19 of the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center.

20 (C) If any such dog or cat is licensed and the
21 license tag has been lost, the same shall, before the
22 release of the dog or cat from the [Animal Shelter]
23 Animal Control Center, be replaced at the expense of the
24 owner at a cost of two dollars, payable to the Animal
25 Regulation Officer.

26 (D) If such dog or cat is unlicensed, its release
27 shall be conditioned upon the delivery of a certificate
28 of vaccination to the Animal Regulation Officer, and the
29 payment to said Animal Regulation Officer of the license
30 fee in accordance with the provisions of this Title,
31 whereupon such owner so reclaiming such dog or cat shall
32 be entitled to a license and numbered license tag.

1 (E) If the dog or cat is unvaccinated, the owner
2 shall also be required to pay such fee as set by the
3 Animal Regulation Officer, for which the owner shall
4 receive a receipt to obtain vaccination of the dog or
5 cat with live-virus vaccine at the office of a veteri-
6 narian in the County to be accomplished within seventy-
7 two hours after the time the dog or cat is released to
8 the owner's custody.

9 SECTION 4: Title 7, Chapter 20, Section 020 of the
10 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 7.20.020: It is unlawful for the owner of any female dog or cat
13 to suffer, permit, or allow their dog or cat to run at
14 large while the dog or cat is in its copulation season,
15 and the owner of such female dog or cat shall keep the
16 same secured upon his premises or in a boarding kennel
17 so that other dogs or cats shall not have access
18 thereto. Every female dog or cat which is not kept in
19 conformance with this Section shall be immediately
20 seized and impounded in the [City Animal Shelter] Animal
21 Control Center and held subject to the provisions of
22 this Chapter.

23 SECTION 5: Title 7, Chapter 20, Section 040 of the
24 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
25 is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 7.20.040: (A) Except as provided in Subsections (B) and (C)
27 of this Section, any animal brought to the [City Animal
28 Shelter] Animal Control Center by any person purporting
29 to be the owner thereof, to be impounded or destroyed,
30 shall be kept by the [City Animal Shelter]
31 Animal Control Center for a period not less than twenty-
32 four hours after impoundment and before disposition as

1 required by law; the person purporting to be the owner
2 of said animal shall pay a reasonable fee to be deter-
3 mined by the Animal Regulation Officer to personnel of
4 the [City Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center upon the
5 delivery of said animal.

6 (B) Any sick or injured animal impounded may be
7 euthanized at any time after impoundment, if, in the
8 professional judgment and certification of a veteri-
9 narian, inhumane suffering may be prevented thereby.

10 (C) Litters of animals up to three months of age
11 and the nursing mothers thereof impounded by the owner
12 for purposes of adoption may be made available for adop-
13 tion by the public immediately after impoundment.

14 SECTION 6: Title 7, Chapter 20, Section 080 of the
15 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
16 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 7.20.080: (A) Any dog or cat impounded in the [Animal
18 Shelter] Animal Control Center as provided in this Title
19 shall be kept for a minimum of one hundred twenty hours;
20 provided, however, that any such dog or cat may, after
21 the first seventy-two hours, be sold or given to any
22 person who shall pay the appropriate license fee as pro-
23 vided in this Title and the cost of vaccination as
24 required in Chapter 7.12.

25 (B) If the ownership of a dog or cat is not proven
26 or if such dog or cat is not sold or given away pursuant
27 to Subsection (A) of this Section within one hundred
28 twenty hours, or within the ten-day period of obser-
29 vation for rabies as provided in Chapter 7.24, such dog
30 or cat may be destroyed in a humane manner in compliance
31 with and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 7.32.260
32 through 7.32.300, under the direction of the Animal

Regulation Officer.

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2 SECTION 7: Title 7, Chapter 24, Section 040 of the
3 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 7.24.040: (A) In the event the biting animal has not been
6 vaccinated against rabies, said animal shall be con-
7 fined, at the owner's expense, separately, in either the
8 animal quarters at the business premises of a veteri-
9 narian, at a commercial kennel, or in the [City Animal
10 Shelter] Animal Control Center for a period of ten days
11 observation, and if not released as provided by law, may
12 be destroyed thereafter. Such animal shall not be
13 released before suitable provisions for vaccination and
14 licensing have been made as set forth in this Chapter.

15 (B) The maximum period of confinement for obser-
16 vation of the unvaccinated animal confined at the [City
17 Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center shall be ten days,
18 even if said animal is obtained from any other govern-
19 mental entity, including, but not limited to, the State,
20 the County, the City of North Las Vegas, the City of
21 Henderson, and the City of Boulder City. If the animal
22 is not released after the maximum ten-day period, as
23 provided by law, it may be destroyed thereafter.

24 SECTION 8: Title 7, Chapter 24, Section 070 of the
25 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
26 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 7.24.070: Rabies suspect-Confinement period. The maximum period
28 of confinement for observation at the [City Animal
29 Shelter] Animal Control Center of a dog or cat known to
30 have or suspected of having rabies shall be ten days,
31 even if said animal is obtained from any other govern-
32 mental entity, including, but not limited to, the State,

1 the County, the City of North Las Vegas, the City of
2 Henderson, and the City of Boulder City. If the animal
3 is not released after the maximum ten-day period, as
4 provided by law, it may be destroyed thereafter. Any
5 other animal known to have or suspected of having rabies
6 shall be confined for observation at the [City Animal
7 Shelter] Animal Control Center for such necessary
8 period of time as shall be determined by the Health
9 Officer, but in no event less than ten days.

10 SECTION 9: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 080 of the
11 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 7.32.080: An Officer of the Metropolitan Police Department or
14 the Animal Regulation Officer or any Animal Control
15 Officer who finds an animal in a motor vehicle in viola-
16 tion of this Chapter may break and enter the motor
17 vehicle if necessary to remove the animal.

18 (A) The Officer removing the animal shall take the
19 animal to the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center or
20 to a veterinary clinic for safekeeping and shall in the
21 event the person having custody cannot be otherwise con-
22 tacted, leave in a prominent place in the motor vehicle
23 a written notice bearing his name and office and the
24 address where the animal may be claimed by the owner
25 thereof.

26 (B) The animal will be surrendered to the owner if
27 the owner claims the animal within seven days from the
28 time the animal was removed from the motor vehicle and
29 pays all reasonable charges that have accrued for the
30 maintenance of the animal. If the owner fails to claim
31 the animal within three days after its removal from the
32 motor vehicle, the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control

1 Center will make reasonable effort to contact the owner
2 and give notice where the animal is in custody and that
3 it may be reclaimed by the owner upon payment of the
4 reasonable maintenance charges.

5 (C) In the event the owner cannot be contacted, or
6 expresses no interest in reclaiming the animal within
7 four days after contact or efforts to contact, the
8 [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center may dispose of
9 the animal, in any reasonable humane manner.

10 SECTION 10: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 100 of the
11 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 7.32.100: (A) Every operator of any vehicle upon the streets
14 and ways of the City shall immediately upon injuring,
15 striking, maiming or running down any animal give such
16 aid as he is reasonably able to render. In the absence
17 of the owner, he shall immediately notify the Animal
18 Regulation Officer furnishing sufficient facts relative
19 to such injury.

20 (B) It is the duty of such operator to remain at
21 or near the scene until the appropriate authorities
22 arrive, and such operator shall immediately identify
23 himself to the appropriate authority.

24 (C) Alternatively, in the absence of the owner, a
25 person may give aid by taking the animal to a veterinary
26 hospital or the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center
27 of the City, and thereafter notifying the Animal
28 Regulation Officer. Such animal shall be deemed an
29 uncared for animal within the meaning of Section
30 7.32.020.

31 (D) Emergency vehicles are not required to stop
32 but shall notify the Animal Regulation Officer, fur-

nishing sufficient facts relative to such injury.

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2 SECTION 11: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 180 of the
3 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 7.32.180: It shall be unlawful for any person who has trapped an
6 animal, or discovers any animal so trapped, to dispose
7 of it in any fashion not otherwise provided by law, but
8 said person shall call the Animal Regulation Officer to
9 have said animal picked up, deliver it to the [City
10 Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center or otherwise
11 dispose of it as directed by the Animal Regulation
12 Officer.

13 SECTION 12: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 210 of the
14 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
15 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 7.32.210: It shall be unlawful for any person to display, sell
17 or offer for sale, barter, give away, or otherwise
18 dispose of any animal upon any street, sidewalk, public
19 building, public park, or other public place, with the
20 exception of the [City Animal Shelter] Animal Control
21 Center.

22 SECTION 13: Title 7, Chapter 36, Section 090 of the
23 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
24 is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 7.36.090: Any animal running at large, except dogs or cats,
26 shall be impounded at the [Animal Shelter]
27 Animal Control Center for seventy-two hours; within
28 which time, if the ownership of the animal is provided
29 and the owner calls for it, he shall be able to remove
30 such animal upon the payment of a fine for its imprison-
31 ment in an amount to be determined by the Animal
32 Regulation Officer, but not in excess of fifty dollars

1 for each imprisonment, which shall go to the credit of
2 the [Animal Shelter], Animal Control Center and five
3 dollars per day for the keep of the animal.

4 SECTION 14: Title 7, Chapter 36, Section 100 of the
5 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 7.36.100: If the ownership of the animal is not proven within
8 one hundred twenty hours, such animal, whether domestic
9 or wild, may be destroyed in a humane manner in
10 compliance with and pursuant to the provisions of
11 Section 7.32.260 through 7.32.300, but such animal may
12 be given or sold, after the first seventy-two hours, to
13 any person. Domestic dogs and cats are specifically
14 exempted from the provision of this Section, and the
15 provisions of Chapter 7.20 shall be applicable to the
16 impounding of dogs and cats. No living animal, wild or
17 domestic, shall be given, sold or transferred by the
18 [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center for experimental
19 use to any person or laboratory.

20 SECTION 15: Title 7, Chapter 40, Section 260 of the
21 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 7.40.260: Any animal kept at the [City Animal Shelter]
24 Animal Control Center in excess of ten days and eight
25 hours may, at the discretion of the Animal Regulation
26 Officer, be euthanized, sold, given away or otherwise
27 disposed of as provided by law.

28 SECTION 16: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
29 paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this ordinance or any
30 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
31 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
32 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of

1 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
2 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
3 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
4 division, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof
5 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
6 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
7 be declared unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective.

8 SECTION 17: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
9 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
10 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
11 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



1 required by law; the person purporting to be the owner
2 of said animal shall pay a reasonable fee to be deter-
3 mined by the Animal Regulation Officer to personnel of
4 the [City Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center upon the
5 delivery of said animal.

6 (B) Any sick or injured animal impounded may be
7 euthanized at any time after impoundment, if, in the
8 professional judgment and certification of a veteri-
9 narian, inhumane suffering may be prevented thereby.

10 (C) Litters of animals up to three months of age
11 and the nursing mothers thereof impounded by the owner
12 for purposes of adoption may be made available for adop-

25 (B) If the ownership of a dog or cat is not proven
26 or if such dog or cat is not sold or given away pursuant
27 to Subsection (A) of this Section within one hundred
28 twenty hours, or within the ten-day period of obser-
29 vation for rabies as provided in Chapter 7.24, such dog
30 or cat may be destroyed in a humane manner in compliance
31 with and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 7.32.260
32 through 7.32.300, under the direction of the Animal

Regulation Officer.

1
2 SECTION 7: Title 7, Chapter 24, Section 040 of the
3 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 7.24.040: (A) In the event the biting animal has not been
6 vaccinated against rabies, said animal shall be con-
7 fined, at the owner's expense, separately, in either the
8 animal quarters at the business premises of a veteri-
9 narian, at a commercial kennel, or in the [City Animal
10 Shelter] Animal Control Center for a period of ten days
11 observation, and if not released as provided by law, may
12 be destroyed thereafter. Such animal shall not be
13 released before suitable provisions for vaccination and
14 licensing have been made as set forth in this Chapter.

15 (B) The maximum period of confinement for obser-
16 vation of the unvaccinated animal confined at the [City
17 Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center shall be ten days,
18 even if said animal is obtained from any other govern-
19 mental entity, including, but not limited to, the State,
20 the County, the City of North Las Vegas, the City of
21 Henderson, and the City of Boulder City. If the animal
22 is not released after the maximum ten-day period, as
23 provided by law, it may be destroyed thereafter.

24 SECTION 8: Title 7, Chapter 24, Section 070 of the
25 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
26 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 7.24.070: Rabies suspect-Confinement period. The maximum period
28 of confinement for observation at the [City Animal
29 Shelter] Animal Control Center of a dog or cat known to
30 have or suspected of having rabies shall be ten days,
31 even if said animal is obtained from any other govern-
32 mental entity, including, but not limited to, the State,

1 the County, the City of North Las Vegas, the City of
2 Henderson, and the City of Boulder City. If the animal
3 is not released after the maximum ten-day period, as
4 provided by law, it may be destroyed thereafter. Any
5 other animal known to have or suspected of having rabies
6 shall be confined for observation at the [City Animal
7 Shelter] Animal Control Center for such necessary
8 period of time as shall be determined by the Health
9 Officer, but in no event less than ten days.

10 SECTION 9: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 080 of the
11 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 7.32.080: An Officer of the Metropolitan Police Department or
14 the Animal Regulation Officer or any Animal Control
15 Officer who finds an animal in a motor vehicle in viola-
16 tion of this Chapter may break and enter the motor
17 vehicle if necessary to remove the animal.

18 (A) The Officer removing the animal shall take the
19 animal to the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center or
20 to a veterinary clinic for safekeeping and shall in the
21 event the person having custody cannot be otherwise con-
22 tacted, leave in a prominent place in the motor vehicle
23 a written notice bearing his name and office and the
24 address where the animal may be claimed by the owner
25 thereof.

26 (B) The animal will be surrendered to the owner if
27 the owner claims the animal within seven days from the
28 time the animal was removed from the motor vehicle and
29 pays all reasonable charges that have accrued for the
30 maintenance of the animal. If the owner fails to claim
31 the animal within three days after its removal from the
32 motor vehicle, the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control

1 Center will make reasonable effort to contact the owner
2 and give notice where the animal is in custody and that
3 it may be reclaimed by the owner upon payment of the
4 reasonable maintenance charges.

5 (C) In the event the owner cannot be contacted, or
6 expresses no interest in reclaiming the animal within
7 four days after contact or efforts to contact, the
8 [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center may dispose of
9 the animal, in any reasonable humane manner.

10 SECTION 10: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 100 of the
11 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 7.32.100: (A) Every operator of any vehicle upon the streets
14 and ways of the City shall immediately upon injuring,
15 striking, maiming or running down any animal give such
16 aid as he is reasonably able to render. In the absence
17 of the owner, he shall immediately notify the Animal
18 Regulation Officer furnishing sufficient facts relative
19 to such injury.

20 (B) It is the duty of such operator to remain at
21 or near the scene until the appropriate authorities
22 arrive, and such operator shall immediately identify
23 himself to the appropriate authority.

24 (C) Alternatively, in the absence of the owner, a
25 person may give aid by taking the animal to a veterinary
26 hospital or the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center
27 of the City, and thereafter notifying the Animal
28 Regulation Officer. Such animal shall be deemed an
29 uncared for animal within the meaning of Section
30 7.32.020.

31 (D) Emergency vehicles are not required to stop
32 but shall notify the Animal Regulation Officer, fur-

nishing sufficient facts relative to such injury.

SECTION 11: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 180 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.32.180: It shall be unlawful for any person who has trapped an animal, or discovers any animal so trapped, to dispose of it in any fashion not otherwise provided by law, but said person shall call the Animal Regulation Officer to have said animal picked up, deliver it to the [City Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center or otherwise dispose of it as directed by the Animal Regulation Officer.

SECTION 12: Title 7, Chapter 32, Section 210 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.32.210: It shall be unlawful for any person to display, sell or offer for sale, barter, give away, or otherwise dispose of any animal upon any street, sidewalk, public building, public park, or other public place, with the exception of the [City Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center.

SECTION 13: Title 7, Chapter 36, Section 090 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.36.090: Any animal running at large, except dogs or cats, shall be impounded at the [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center for seventy-two hours; within which time, if the ownership of the animal is provided and the owner calls for it, he shall be able to remove such animal upon the payment of a fine for its imprisonment in an amount to be determined by the Animal Regulation Officer, but not in excess of fifty dollars

1 for each imprisonment, which shall go to the credit of
2 the [Animal Shelter], Animal Control Center and five
3 dollars per day for the keep of the animal.

4 SECTION 14: Title 7, Chapter 36, Section 100 of the
5 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 7.36.100: If the ownership of the animal is not proven within
8 one hundred twenty hours, such animal, whether domestic
9 or wild, may be destroyed in a humane manner in
10 compliance with and pursuant to the provisions of
11 Section 7.32.260 through 7.32.300, but such animal may
12 be given or sold, after the first seventy-two hours, to
13 any person. Domestic dogs and cats are specifically
14 exempted from the provision of this Section, and the
15 provisions of Chapter 7.20 shall be applicable to the
16 impounding of dogs and cats. No living animal, wild or
17 domestic, shall be given, sold or transferred by the
18 [Animal Shelter] Animal Control Center for experimental
19 use to any person or laboratory.

20 SECTION 15: Title 7, Chapter 40, Section 260 of the
21 Las Vegas Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1983 Edition,
22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 7.40.260: Any animal kept at the [City Animal Shelter]
24 Animal Control Center in excess of ten days and eight
25 hours may, at the discretion of the Animal Regulation
26 Officer, be euthanized, sold, given away or otherwise
27 disposed of as provided by law.

28 SECTION 16: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
29 paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this ordinance or any
30 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
31 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
32 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of

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the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
division, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof
irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
be declared unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective.

SECTION 17: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

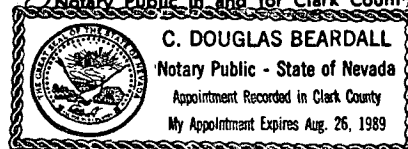

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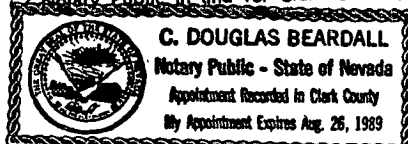
