17 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

18 SECTION 1: Title 19, Chapter 90, Section 80, of the
19 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, of
20 the is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 19.90.080: Following the conduct of a public hearing on any
22 application for a special use permit to allow a pawnshop; a
23 retail demonstration merchandise sales store; a Class III or
24 other secondhand dealer, except for an antique store or used car
25 lot; a transient sales lot; an open sales lot; a custodial insti-
26 tution or a detention facility; a publicly-operated convention
27 and stadium facility; mini-storage facilities; off-premises
28 signs; a liquefied petroleum gas installation, a gaming estab-
29 lishment (hotel); a plasma donor center or a rescue mission, the
30 Board of Zoning Adjustment shall formulate its recommendation
31 either to approve or to deny such application and, if such
32 recommendation is for approval, shall report [its] such
recommendation [on said application] to the City Council. Prior
to the next subsequent meeting of the City Council, the Secretary
of the Board of Zoning Adjustment shall transmit a copy of said

1 recommendation to the City Clerk. Within not to exceed thirty
2 days from the date of the Board of Zoning Adjustment's recommen-
3 dation, the City Council shall set the date for a public hearing,
4 and public notice shall be given by the City Clerk not less than
5 ten days prior to the public hearing to all property owners who
6 received notice of the public hearing conducted by the Board of
7 Zoning Adjustment. The City Council shall consider the applica-
8 tion for said special use permit and the recommendation of the
9 Board of Zoning Adjustment at the public hearing. Action by the
10 City Council on such application, following a public hearing,
11 shall be by majority vote of the entire Council and shall be
12 final and conclusive.

13 If the recommendation of the Board of Zoning Adjustment
14 is for the denial of such application, such recommendation shall
15 constitute a denial of the application unless the applicant
16 appeals such denial in accordance with Section 19.90.070.

17 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
18 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
19 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
20 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
21 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
22 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.

24 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
25 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
26 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-



4 am not bound by any allegiance to any foreign prince, poten-



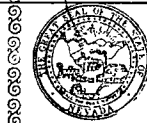
