AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 28, SECTION 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO DEFINE A PARK RESERVE OFFICER AS AN OFFICER WHO WILL ACT IN THE CAPACITY OF A PARK SECURITY OFFICER ONLY WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY STATUS; AMENDING SECTION 20 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO CREATE A VOLUNTEER RESERVE PARK RANGER PROGRAM AS A PART OF THE PARK RANGER UNIT; AMENDING SECTION 70 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO PROVIDE THAT A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PARK RESERVE OFFICER MUST MEET THE SAME QUALIFICATIONS AS A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PARK SECURITY OFFICER; AMENDING SECTION 80 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO PROVIDE THAT A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PARK RESERVE OFFICER WILL BE BARRED FROM APPOINTMENT FOR THE SAME REASONS THAT A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PARK SECURITY OFFICER WOULD BE BARRED; AMENDING SECTION 100 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO PROVIDE FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PARK RESERVE OFFICER; AMENDING SECTION 110 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO REQUIRE THAT EACH PARK RESERVE OFFICER COMPLETE A CITY-APPROVED TRAINING PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.28.010: As used in this Chapter:

(A) "City Park Ranger Unit" means those persons who are employed by the City as City Park Security Officers and those persons who volunteer and are appointed by the City as Park Reserve Officers, who comply with this Chapter and who are designated by the Director of Detention and Correctional Services as members of the City Park Ranger Unit;

(B) "City Park Security Officer" means any person who is employed by the City to patrol the City parks, recreation

1 areas and such other City facilities as may be designated by the  
2 City Manager or his designee, to protect people and property  
3 within the boundaries thereof and to perform other duties as  
4 assigned. Such a person shall be known as a "Park Ranger."

5 (C) "City Park Reserve Officer" means any person who,  
6 as a volunteer to the City, has been designated by the Director  
7 of Detention and Correctional Services to be a City Park Reserve  
8 Officer. A City Park Reserve Officer shall act as a City Park  
9 Security Officer only when he is serving in an on-duty capacity  
10 and is engaged in the actual performance of his duties, as  
11 assigned by the Director of Detention and Correctional Services.  
12 Such a person shall be known as a "Reserve Park Ranger."

13 SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 20, of the  
14 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
15 hereby amended to read as follows:

16 2.28.020: There is established a City Park Ranger Unit under  
17 the Department of Detention and Correctional Services. It shall  
18 consist of those City Park Security Officers and City Park  
19 Reserve Officers who[, complying] comply with this Chapter and  
20 are designated by the Director of Detention and Correctional Ser-  
21 vices and approved by the City Manager.

22 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 70, of the  
23 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
24 hereby amended to read as follows:

25 2.28.070: The City Manager or his designee shall not hire any  
26 person as a City Park Security Officer or appoint any person as a  
27 City Park Reserve Officer unless:

- 28 (A) He is at least twenty-one years of age;
- 29 (B) He is a citizen of the United States or is lawfully  
30 entitled to reside and work in the United States; and
- 31 (C) He is of sound mind and good moral character.

32 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 80, of the

1 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision,  
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
3 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
4 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
5 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
6 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
7 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
8 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
9 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-  
10 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-  
11 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared  
12 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 8: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,  
14 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
16 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.





7 the unlawful use or possession of a firearm;

8 (B) He suffers from alcoholism, addiction to narcotics  
9 or has any other disability which, in the judgment of the City  
10 Manager, would prevent him from performing services as a Park  
11 Security Officer or as a City Park Reserve Officer, as the case  
12 may be, or would detract from the image or prestige of a Park  
13 Security Officer or of a City Park Reserve Officer.

14 SECTION 5: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 100, of the  
15 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
16 hereby amended to read as follows:

17 2.28.100: The Department of Personnel and Employee Relations  
18 shall investigate each applicant to determine whether or not the  
19 facts that are set forth in the application are true and whether  
20 or not the applicant is qualified to serve as a City Park  
21 Security Officer or a City Park Reserve Officer, as the case may  
22 be. The misrepresentation or omission of relevant information  
23 [shall constitute] constitutes grounds for automatic disqualifi-  
24 cation.

25 SECTION 6: Title 2, Chapter 28, Section 110, of the  
26 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
27 hereby amended to read as follows:

28 2.28.110: Each City Park Security Officer and each City Park  
29 Reserve Officer shall complete a City-approved training program  
30 as directed by the Director of Detention and Correctional Ser-  
31 vices.

32 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision,

1 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
2 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
3 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
4 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
