12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
13 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: Title 13, Chapter 20, Section 110, of the
15 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
16 hereby amended to read as follows:

17 13.20.110: Excavations in the City right-of-way shall be prop-
18 erly protected by barricade methods as provided under the
19 manual entitled ["Street Barricading and Channelization
20 Manual for Temporary Traffic Control, City of Las Vegas,
21 Nevada, 1966."] "Nevada Work Zone Traffic Control Handbook,
22 1985 Edition." Any person maintaining improper barricades
23 within street rights-of-way which require the placing of
24 additional barricades, warning lights or signs by the City in
25 the interest of public safety shall be charged fifty dollars
26 for each occasion in which the City finds it necessary to
27 place the barricades.

28 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
29 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
30 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
31 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
32 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of

1 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
2 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it
3 would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
4 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of the
5 fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
6 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
7 tional, invalid or ineffective.

8 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
9 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
10 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
11 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
