3 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL; AMENDING TITLE 11,
4 CHAPTER 16, SECTION 70, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS
5 VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN THE
6 PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN STREETS IN FIVE
7 MILES PER HOUR INCREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY
8 RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF;
9 AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT
10 HEREWITH.

8 Sponsored By: Summary: Provides for increases in
9 Councilman Ron Lurie the prima facie speed limits in five
miles per hour increments.

10 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
11 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

12 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 16, Section 70, of the
13 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 11.16.070: When signs are erected giving notice thereof, the
16 prima facie speed limit upon those streets or highways or
17 portions thereof described in Schedule 25-I shall be thirty
18 miles per hour, Schedule 25-II shall be thirty-five miles per
19 hour, Schedule 25-III shall be [~~forty-five~~] forty miles per
20 hour, Schedule 25-IV shall be [~~fifty-five~~] forty-five miles
21 per hour, [and] Schedule 25-V shall be [~~sixty-five~~] fifty
22 miles per hour[.] and Schedule 25-VI shall be fifty-five
23 miles per hour. Copies of said schedules shall be maintained
24 for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk and the
25 City Traffic Engineer and may be amended from time to time by
26 resolution of the [Board of Commissioners;] City Council;
27 provided, however, that when traffic engineering studies
28 indicate that through intersections of any street or highway,
29 or any other point along such street or highway, a speed in
30 excess of twenty-five miles per hour would be unsafe due to
31 the number of children crossing such street or highway at
32 such intersection or other point on their way to or from

1 school, the Traffic Engineer shall designate such intersec-
2 tion as a "school crossing," and when signs are erected
3 giving notice thereof, the prima facie speed limit through
4 such "school crossing" and for a distance of two hundred feet
5 on either side thereof shall be twenty-five miles per hour
6 when children are going to or leaving school during school
7 hours on days on which schools are in session.

8 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
10 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
11 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
12 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
13 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
14 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it
15 would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
16 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of the
17 fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
18 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
19 tional, invalid or ineffective.



20 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is
21 prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or
22 a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
23 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
24 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such
25 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
26 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
27 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
28 for a term of not more than six (6) months, or by any combination
29 of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
30 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

31 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
32 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs

2 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
