Ordinance No. 3204

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 6, CHAPTER 24 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY REPEALING SECTION 76 AND ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION REQUIRING FINGER-PRINTING BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OF ANY PERSON WHO OWNS, OPERATES, IS EMPLOYED BY OR IS A RESIDENT OF A CHILD CARE FACILITY; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Amends child care facilities ordinance by requiring fingerprinting through the Federal Bureau of Investigation of any person who owns, operates, is employed by or is a resident of a child care facility.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 24, Section 76 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 24 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 76, to read as follows:

6.24.076: Every person required to make application for licensing under this Chapter shall be referred by the Department of Business Activity to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department for fingerprinting. In addition to the work card procedures outlined in Chapter 6.86, the applicant shall submit the required fees for processing of fingerprint cards through the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

SECTION 3: Title 6, Chapter 24, Section 356 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 6.24.356: (A) Any person, whether a full or part-time employee[,
2 volunteer] or trainee, and whether or not paid,
3 in the employ of a licensed facility, shall
4 possess a valid police work card for child care
5 issued by the Metropolitan Police Department and
6 a valid health card issued by the District Health
7 Department prior to the actual commencement of
8 services with children.

9 (B) [Any] Every person over eighteen years of age who
10 resides in a facility [may] shall be required
11 to obtain a police [or health card] work card[, or
12 both.] for child care.

13 (C) In addition to the provisions outlined in Chapter
14 6.86, the procedures for obtaining a police work
15 card shall include submission of required fees
16 for processing fingerprint cards through the
17 Federal Bureau of Investigation.

18 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 24, Section 510 of the
19 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
20 is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 6.24.510: An accommodation facility shall provide adequate
22 supervision of and sanitary facilities for children
23 in its custody. In any such facility:

24 (A) An adequate record of children cared for shall
25 be maintained; and
26 (B) Each person who provides care shall be at least
27 eighteen years of age and shall possess valid
28 police and health cards.

29 (C) In addition to the provisions outlined under
30 Chapter 6.86, the procedures for obtaining a
31 police work card shall include submission of
32 required fees for processing of fingerprint cards

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through the Federal Bureau of Investigation.


SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


