AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SCHOOL ZONES; AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 2, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION, DESIGNATED AS SECTION 165, WHICH PROVIDES A DEFINITION OF "SCHOOL CROSSINGS"; AMENDING SECTION 170 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL TO DESIGNATE "SCHOOL ZONES"; AMENDING CHAPTER 16, SECTION 20, OF SAID TITLE TO CLARIFY THE APPLICATION OF THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMIT IN SCHOOL ZONES; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Conforms City's School Zone Speed Limits Ordinance to a new State law.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 2, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be designated as Section 165, reading as follows:

11.02.165 "School crossing" means those locations, designated by the Traffic Engineer, which are used by children crossing to and from school.

SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 2, Section 170, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.02.170: "School zone" includes all streets designated by the City Council which are contiguous to school grounds.

SECTION 3: Title 11, Chapter 16, Section 20, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.16.020: The prima facie speed limit shall be fifteen miles per hour when [passing] in a school [building or the grounds thereof adjacent to the street or highway while

2 during school hours on days on which such school is
3 in session[,] and upon the grounds or parking lots
4 thereof at all times. Such prima facie limit also shall
5 apply when [passing] in any school [grounds] zone which
6 is adjacent to the grounds of any school that are not
7 separated from the street or highway by a fence, gate
8 or any other physical barrier[,] while such grounds
9 are in use by children.

10 SECTION 4: Title 11, Chapter 46, Section 10, of the
11 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
12 hereby amended to read as follows:

13 11.46.010: Those portions of streets that are described in
14 Schedule 27-I, copies of which shall be maintained for
15 public inspection in the offices of the City Clerk and
16 the [City] Traffic Engineer and may be amended from
17 time to time by resolution of the [Board of Commission-
18 ers, and such other portions of streets] City Council
19 that are contiguous to school sites, are hereby
20 designated as "school zones."

21 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
22 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
23 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
24 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
25 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
26 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
27 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares
28 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
29 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
30 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
31 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
32 tional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 6: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
