14 THE PARKING METER ZONE; AMENDING SECTION 110 OF SAID TITLE AND
15 CHAPTER TO INCREASE FROM 10¢ PER HOUR TO 25¢ PER HOUR THE FEE
16 THAT IS DESIGNATED THEREIN FOR PARKING OR STANDING A VEHICLE IN A
17 CITY-OWNED PARKING LOT; AMENDING SECTION 180 OF SAID TITLE AND
18 CHAPTER TO ADD THE MAINTENANCE OF THE AREAS IN THE VICINITY OF
19 THE PARKING METERS AND THE CITY-OWNED PARKING LOTS TO THE
20 PERMITTED USES OF THE REVENUES THEREFROM THAT ARE SPECIFIED IN
21 SAID SECTION; REPEALING SECTIONS 120 TO 160, INCLUSIVE, OF SAID
22 TITLE AND CHAPTER; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING
23 THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN
24 CONFLICT HERewith.

18 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
19 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 54, Section 90, of the
21 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
22 hereby amended to read as follows:

23 11.54.090: Parking meters shall be operated in the parking meter
24 zone every day between the hours of nine a.m. and six
25 p.m., except Sundays and holidays, and except as herein-
26 after in Section 11.54.100(B) expressly provided. With-
27 in the meaning of this Chapter, the term "holiday" shall
28 include the following days only: January 1st, the
29 third Monday in January, the third Monday in February,
30 the last Monday in May, July 4th, the first Monday in
31 September, October 31st, November 11th, the fourth
32 Thursday in November, the fourth Friday in November,

1 December 25th and any general holiday declared by the
2 President of the United States, Governor of the state or
3 Mayor of the City except for any presidential appoint-
4 ment of the fourth Monday in October as Veterans Day;
5 provided also that if any of these holidays falls upon a
6 Saturday or a Sunday, then the preceding Friday or
7 following Monday, respectively, shall [also] be con-
8 sidered [a] the holiday; provided, however, that by
9 resolution of the majority of its members, the [Board of
10 Commissioners] City Council may extend the time for
11 operation of any parking meters in the parking meter
12 zone for an additional period of time, provided the
13 proper notice for such extended time of operation is
14 placed on each such parking meter.

15 SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 54, Section 100, of the
16 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
17 hereby amended to read as follows:

18 11.54.100: [(A)] Parking or standing a vehicle in a designated
19 parking meter space on the [following named]
20 streets and parts of streets that are designated in
21 Schedule 3-I, as the same is established pursuant
22 to LVMC 11.54.020, shall be lawful for [six minutes
23 for each one-cent] twelve or fifteen minutes, as
24 may be designated on the particular meter, for a
25 five-cent coin of the United States of America, or
26 for thirty minutes for [each five-cent] a ten-cent
27 coin of the United States of America[,] or for
28 sixty minutes for [each ten-cent] a twenty-five
29 cent coin of the United States of America, depo-
30 sited in the meter for such parking meter
31 space[.

32 (1) On Fremont Street from Third Street to Ninth

Street;

(2) On Carson Avenue from Main Street to Seventh Street;

(3) On Ogden Avenue from Main Street to Sixth Street;

(4) On Las Vegas Boulevard from Bridger Avenue to Stewart Avenue;

(5) On the east side of Third Street from Carson Avenue to Ogden Avenue;

(6) On Fourth Street, Sixth Street, Seventh Street and Eighth Street from Carson Avenue to Ogden Avenue;]

limited, however, to such maximum total time for parking as shall be prescribed by the order of the [Board of Commissioners] City Council from time to time and so indicated by proper notice upon such parking meter[; provided, however, that the Board of Commissioners may from time to time by resolution provide that parking meter heads shall be installed within the areas hereinabove set forth having thereon receptacles for a five-cent minimum only, and containing no receptacle for the deposit of a one-cent coins, in which even the minimum parking time so designated shall be thirty minutes for each five-cent coin of the United States of America].

[(B) (1) Parking or standing a vehicle in a designated parking meter space on the following named streets and parts of streets shall be lawful for one hour for each ten-cent coin of the United States of America, deposited in the meter for such parking meter space:

1 including the west side of Third Street;

2 (b) On Main Street, First Street and Casino
3 Center Boulevard between Ogden and Carson
4 Avenues, but not including any portion of
5 Ogden or Carson Avenues.

6 (2) In the area designated in this Subsection (B),
7 the depositing of a ten-cent coin of the
8 United States of America for parking or
9 standing a vehicle in a designated parking
10 meter space therein shall be required between
11 the hours of nine a.m. and six p.m. each day,
12 not including Sundays or holidays.

13 (C) Parking or standing a vehicle in a designated
14 parking meter space in any other portion of the
15 parking meter zone shall be lawful for twelve min-
16 utes for each one-cent coin of the United States of
17 America, or for sixty minutes for each five-cent
18 coin of the United States of America, deposited in
19 the meter for such parking meter space; limited,
20 however, to such maximum total time for parking as
21 shall be prescribed by the proper order of the
22 Board from time to time and so indicated by proper
23 notice placed upon such parking meter.]

24 SECTION 3: Title 11, Chapter 54, Section 110, of the
25 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
26 hereby amended to read as follows:

27 11.54.110: Parking or standing a vehicle in any of the City
28 owned parking lots shall be at the following rates:

29 (A) In the Fourth and Stewart Lot, located on the west
30 side of Fourth Street between Stewart and Mesquite
31 [Streets, five-cents coin of the United States of
32 America for each one-half hour, ten cents coin of

1 the United States of America for each one hour,
2 and] Avenues, a twenty-five [cents] cent coin of
3 the United States of America for each [two hours,]
4 hour, with a maximum time limit of four hours;

5 (B) In the Las Vegas [Blvd.] Boulevard North and
6 Stewart Lot, located on the south side of Stewart
7 Avenue between Las Vegas [Blvd.] Boulevard North
8 and [4th] Fourth Street, [five cents coin of the
9 United States of America for each one-half hour,
10 ten cents coin of the United States of America for
11 each one hour, and] a twenty-five [cents] cent coin
12 of the United States of America for each [two
13 hours,] hour, with a maximum of four hours.

14 SECTION 4: Title 11, Chapter 54, Section 180, of the
15 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
16 hereby amended to read as follows:

17 11.54.180: The coins deposited in parking meters are required
18 and shall be used to defray the expense of proper regu-
19 lation of traffic and parking upon the public streets of
20 the City, to provide for the cost of supervision, regu-
21 lation and control of the parking of vehicles in parking
22 meter zones[,] and other areas in which parking is
23 restricted and to cover the cost of purchase, super-
24 vision, protection, inspection, installation, operation,
25 maintenance, control and use of parking meters[.] as
26 well as the public areas in the vicinity of the parking
27 meters and the zones in which parking is restricted.


28 SECTION 5: Title 11, Chapter 54, Sections 120 to 160,
29 inclusive, are hereby repealed.


30 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision
31 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
32 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or

1 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
2 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
3 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
4 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
5 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,
6 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
7 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
8 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

9 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
10 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
11 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
12 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
