AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLLECTION, HAULING AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE; AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 8, SECTIONS 140, 150, 160 AND 170, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO ESTABLISH A REVISED SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR COLLECTING, HAULING AND DISPOSING OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY EITHER BY SAID CITY OR BY ITS AUTHORIZED CONTRACTOR; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Sponsored By: Mayor Ron Lurie Summary: Establishing a schedule of charges for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.140: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from single-family residences on a twice-a-week basis shall be [as follows: eighteen dollars] twenty dollars and seventy cents per quarter, payable in advance, each and every three-month period.

SECTION 2: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 150, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.150: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from apartments and multiple units on a twice-a-week basis shall be a flat rate to be computed as follows: [thirteen dollars and forty-three] fifteen dollars and forty-four cents for the first unit on one stop and [nine dollars and forty] ten dollars and eighty-one cents for each additional unit on one stop, irrespective of occupancy or vacancy of any such additional unit or units, payable each and every three-month period. Should three-days-a-week service be

1 requested by any apartments or multiple units, the rate for such
2 service shall be one and one-half times that for service on a
3 twice-a-week basis and should six-[day] days-a-week service be
4 requested by any apartments or multiple units, the rate for such
5 service shall be two and one-half times that for service [for] on
6 a twice-a-week basis.

7 SECTION 3: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 160, of the
8 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
9 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 9.08.160: The charge for collecting [and], hauling and
11 disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from
12 [auto courts] motels and mobile home parks on a twice-a-week
13 basis, shall be as follows:

25 collection at each mobile home, the service will be the same
26 as residential service with a heavy item pick up provided,
27 and the rate shall be twenty dollars and seventy cents per
28 unit per quarter; provided, however, that the rate for such
29 individual collection without the heavy item pick up shall be
30 fifteen dollars and forty-four cents per unit per quarter.
31 Should three-day-a-week service be requested by any motel or
32 mobile home park, the rate for such service shall be one and

1 one-half times that for service on a twice-a-week basis and
 2 should six-[day] days-a-week service be requested by any
 3 [auto courts and] motel or mobile home [parks,] park, the
 4 rate for such service shall be two and one-half times that
 5 for service [for] on a twice-a-week basis.

6 SECTION 4: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 170, of the
 7 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
 8 hereby amended to read as follows:

9 9.08.170: The quarterly charge for collecting, hauling and
 10 disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from
 11 hotels, places of business and public buildings shall be deter-
 12 mined by the number and type of receptacles required by each such
 13 hotel, place of business or public building and by the number of
 14 daily collections from each per week in accordance with the
 15 following table:


36 SECTION 5: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 180, of the
 37 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
 38 hereby amended to read as follows:


1 9.08.180: All garbage collection charges or fees prescribed
2 in Sections 9.08.140 through 9.08.170 of this Chapter shall be
3 due and payable quarterly in advance on the first day of each
4 January, April, July and October. In the event any person fails
5 to pay such charge or fee within fifteen days after it becomes
6 due and payable, such charge shall be considered delinquent and
7 [a] an annual penalty of ten percent of such charge or fee shall
8 be added thereto.

9 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
11 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
12 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
13 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
14 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
15 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
16 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
17 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
18 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-
19 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
20 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

21 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
22 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
23 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
24 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
