3 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL; AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER
4 48, SECTION 30 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1983
5 EDITION, TO AUTHORIZE SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS UPON THE USE OF TRUCK
6 ROUTES TO PROMOTE THE HEALTH SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC;
7 PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES
8 FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF
9 ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Provides for the authority to
impose specific restrictions on truck routes.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
10 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 48, of the Municipal Code of the City of
12 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be
13 designated as Section 30, reading as follows:

14 11.48.030: Notwithstanding any of the other provisions of this Chapter, no vehicle in excess
15 of eight thousand pounds unladen weight shall be operated or moved upon any
16 public street, highway or alley within the City, except upon truck routes, as set
17 forth in Schedule 29-II [, copies of which]. The City Council may impose specific
18 restrictions upon the use of any of the enumerated truck routes, where such
19 restrictions are deemed warranted in order to promote the health, safety and
20 welfare of the public. Any such restrictions shall be included in Schedule 29-II.
21 Copies of Schedule 29-II shall be maintained for public inspection in the offices of
22 the City Clerk and the City Traffic Engineer and may be amended from time to
23 time by resolution of the [Board of Commissioners, or] City Council. Such
24 vehicles may also travel upon temporary truck routes hereafter designated by the
25 Department of Public [Services] Works pursuant to Section 11.48.070[, unless].
26 Travel by any vehicle in excess of eight thousand pounds unladen weight on a non-
truck route may occur only if merchandise, freight or other supplies are to be

1 picked up by or delivered from such vehicle, or [unless] such vehicle is required
2 in the performance or service, repair, construction or similar essential use;
3 provided, however, that in any such event [such] the vehicle shall use the shortest
4 possible route from a designated truck route to the point of pickup, delivery or
5 essential use and shall return therefrom to the nearest designated truck route;
6 provided further, that the [following] additional restrictions set out in Sections
7 11.48.040, 11.48.050 and 11.48.060 shall apply.

8 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,
9 sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be
10 unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision
11 shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part
12 thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed
13 each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective
14 of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses
15 or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

16 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made
17 or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the
18 doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an
19 offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required
20 act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not
21 more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any
22 combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall
23 constitute a separate offense.

24 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections,

2 Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
