ORDINANCE No. 2204

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER 23 OF TITLE X OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, AS ADDED TO SAID TITLE BY ORDINANCE NO. 2173 OF SAID CITY, BY ADDING THERETO TWO NEW SECTIONS; ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO INSTITUTE, OBTAIN APPROVAL FOR, SUPERVISE AND MONITOR THE OPERATIONS OF A PROGRAM OF EDUCATION AND COUNSELING ON THE USE AND ABUSE OF ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE COMPOSITION OF SAID COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES FOR THE MEMBERS THEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 23 of Title X of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, as added to said Title by Ordinance No. 2173 of said City, is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as Sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: There is hereby created a committee, consisting of the Judges of the Las Vegas Municipal Court, to institute, obtain approval for, supervise and monitor the operations of a program of education and counseling on the use and abuse of alcohol and controlled substances for the benefit of persons who are convicted in said Municipal Court of violating any City ordinance corresponding to NRS 484.379(1) or NRS 484.379(2).

SECTION 3: A. Until the beginning of the term of office following the primary and general elections held in May and June of 1983:

1. Any member of the committee established pursuant to this Chapter whose annual salary as a Judge of

1 the Las Vegas Municipal Court is Thirty-seven Thousand
2 Five Hundred Dollars (\$37,500.00) shall receive no
3 salary as a member of said committee.

4 2. Any member of said committee whose annual
5 salary as a Judge of the Las Vegas Municipal Court is
6 Twenty-six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000.00) is entitled to
7 receive as a member of said committee an annual salary
8 of Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$11,500.00).

9 B. From and after the expiration of the term of office
10 of the members of said committee whose terms of office as
11 Judges of the Las Vegas Municipal Court began following the
12 primary and general elections held in May and June of 1979,
13 no member of said committee shall receive any salary as a
14 member of said committee.

15 SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
16 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
17 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
18 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such deci-
19 sion shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
20 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
21 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares
22 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
23 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the
24 fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
25 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
26 tional, invalid or ineffective.

27 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
