AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIRE REGULATIONS; AMENDING TITLE VII, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY REPEALING CHAPTER 1 OF SAID TITLE RELATING TO FIRE ZONES, BY REPEALING SECTION 3 OF CHAPTER 5 OF SAID TITLE, ENTITLED "SMOKING IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION," BY REPEALING CHAPTER 6 OF SAID TITLE RELATING TO LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS, BY REPEALING CHAPTER 7 OF SAID TITLE RELATING TO ADULT GROUP CARE FACILITIES, BY REPEALING CHAPTER 8 OF SAID TITLE RELATING TO MOBILE HOME CONSTRUCTION; AND BY ADDING TO SAID TITLE A NEW CHAPTER, DESIGNATED CHAPTER 9, CONTAINING MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS TO BE ENFORCED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE SERVICES; REPEALING TITLE III, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 1 OF SAID CODE RELATING TO FIRE HYDRANTS; REPEALING TITLE VIII, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7 OF SAID CODE RELATING TO THE BURNING OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH; REPEALING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 1, SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF SAID CODE RELATING TO FIRES AND FIREWORKS IN CITY STREETS; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: As part of the new codification project, repeals obsolete provisions relating to fire zones, smoking in public transportation, liquified petroleum gas, adult group care facilities, and mobile home construction. Also transfers from other Titles to Title X provisions relating to fires, fireworks and fire hydrants in city streets.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title VII, Chapters 1, 6, 7 and 8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Title VII, Chapter 5, Section 3, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3: Title III, Chapter 2, Section 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 4: Title VIII, Chapter 3, Section 7, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

1 SECTION 5: Title IX, Chapter 1, Sections 1 and 2, of
2 the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, are
3 hereby repealed in their entirety.

4 SECTION 6: Title VII of the Municipal Code of the
5 City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding
6 thereto a new Chapter, designated as Chapter 9, reading as
7 follows:

8 7-9-1: BUILDING FIRE IN STREETS:

9 It shall be unlawful for any person to kindle or use any
10 fire or to make a bonfire upon any public street, alley or
11 public ground within the City.

12 7-9-2: FIREWORKS ON STREETS:

13 It shall be unlawful for any person upon any day of
14 celebration, carnival, holiday or upon any other day or time,
15 to throw, discharge or cause to be thrown or discharged upon
16 any street or on, in or under any vehicle upon any street, or
17 upon any sidewalk within the limits of the City, any bomb,
18 firecracker, or other character of fireworks.

19 7-9-3: SHUTTING WATER OFF:

20 It shall be the duty of any person who supplies water to
21 the City and its inhabitants through hydrants located upon
22 the streets, alleys and public places in the City, whenever,
23 by reason of repairs or work or from any cause, it becomes
24 necessary to turn the water off from any such hydrant, to
25 notify the chief or other head of the Fire Department of the
26 City of the need to do so, before the water is turned off,
27 and the length of time such hydrant will remain without
28 water.

29 7-9-4: BURNING OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH:

30 It shall be unlawful for any person, for the purpose of
31 burning garbage, rubbish, dead animals or dirt, to kindle or
32 maintain any bonfire or knowingly to furnish the materials

1 for any such fire, or to authorize any such fire to be
2 kindled or maintained in any garbage or rubbish receptacle,
3 or on any street, alley, road, lane or public grounds or upon
4 any private lot; provided, however, that rubbish may be
5 burned in an incinerator duly approved by both the Fire Chief
6 and the Building Inspector.

7 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
8 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
9 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
10 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such deci-
11 sion shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
12 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
13 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares
14 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
15 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the
16 fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
17 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
18 tional, invalid or ineffective.

19 SECTION 8: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
20 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
21 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
22 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


