AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CONVENTIONS AND TRADE SHOW OPERATORS AND EXHIBITORS; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF CONVENTION AND TRADE SHOW OPERATORS AND CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THEREFROM; REQUIRING CERTAIN CONVENTION AND TRADE SHOW EXHIBITORS TO BE LISTED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ACTIVITY; REQUIRING LICENSE FEES AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Summary: Provides for the licensing of convention and trade show operators

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V of the Municipal Code, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to add a new Chapter 12 as follows:

5-12-1: Definitions:

(A) "Convention exhibitor" means any person who sells, offers for sale or solicits orders for the sale of goods or services on a temporary basis at a bona fide international, national, state or local convention.

(B) "Convention operator" means any person who sponsors or organizes a convention wherein space is provided for convention exhibitors.

(C) "Trade show exhibitor" means any person who sells, offers for sale or solicits orders for the sale of goods or services on a temporary basis at a bona fide international, national, state or local trade show or fair.

(D) "Trade show operator" means any person who sponsors or organizes a trade show wherein space is provided for a trade show exhibitor.

5-11-2: Excepted from the provisions of this chapter and the

1 licensing requirements of LVC Title V is the sale,
2 offer for sale or the solicitation of orders at a
3 trade show or convention where the attendance at which
4 is restricted and the general public is not invited.

5 5-12-3: No person shall act as a convention operator or trade
6 show operator at a convention or trade show which is
7 open to the general public without first obtaining and
8 thereafter maintaining a valid unexpired license
9 pursuant to this code.

10 5-12-4: The following conditions must be satisfied in order to
11 qualify for a license.

12 (A) The convention or trade show exhibitors may only
13 be allowed to operate for 14 days or less at any
14 one convention or trade show.

15 (B) The convention or trade show must be conducted
16 at a publicly owned convention or other facility,
17 a hotel having 150 rooms or more or a commercial
18 building having at least 250,000 square feet.

19 5-12-5: Each convention or trade show operator in applying for
20 a license must:

21 (A) List the name and address of each exhibitor;
22 (B) Describe in general terms the goods or services
23 offered by each exhibitor;
24 (C) Pay in advance a license fee in the amount of
25 \$7.00 per day for each exhibitor.

26 5-12-6: Each license issued shall be limited to the days approved
27 for operation.

28 5-12-7: It is unlawful for any person to act or conduct
29 business as a convention or trade show exhibitor at a
30 convention or trade show which is open to the general
31 public unless such person is listed with the Department
32 under an operator's license pursuant to LVC 5-12-5.

1 SECTION 2: Title V, Chapter 11, Section 1 of the
2 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 5-11-1: Definitions: As used in this Chapter, unless the
5 context otherwise requires, the following words shall
6 have the meaning ascribed to them:

7 (A) "Food" means all edible things, including drinks.

8 (B) "Mobile Food Vendor" means a person who peddles or
9 solicits food by means of a vehicle.

10 (C) "Peddle or Solicit" means selling, offering for
11 sale or soliciting orders for goods or services
12 upon the streets, sidewalks or alleys of the city,
13 or by going from dwelling to dwelling or place to
14 place whether by foot or by other means of trans-
15 portation.

16 (D) "Temporary Merchant" means any person who engages in
17 the temporary business of selling, offering for
18 sale or soliciting orders for goods or services
19 from a permanent or fixed location. A business
20 shall be deemed temporary if its fixed location is
21 for a period of 31 days or less. Temporary
22 merchant shall not include, however, an exhibitor
23 at a convention or trade show who is [properly]
24 either registered pursuant to [LVC 5-12-5.] LVC
25 Title 5, Chapter 12 or exempted from its provisions.


26 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is pro-
27 hibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or
28 a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
29 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
30 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such
31 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
32 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be

1 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
2 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
3 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
4 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

5 SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
6 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
7 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
8 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such de-
9 cision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the re-
10 maining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board
11 of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
12 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection,
13 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,
14 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
15 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases
16 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

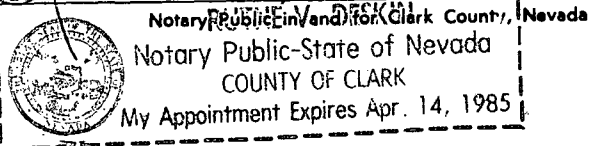
