3 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING TAXES ON TRANSIENT LODGING; AMENDING VARIOUS  
4 PROVISIONS OF TITLE 4, CHAPTER 20, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS  
5 VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO IMPLEMENT STATE LAW BY INCREASING FROM  
6 ONE PERCENT TO TWO PERCENT THE SUPPLEMENTAL ROOM TAX FOR THE BENEFIT  
7 OF CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND BY  
8 INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF INTEREST DUE ON DELINQUENT AMOUNTS FROM ONE  
9 PERCENT TO ONE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT PER MONTH; PROVIDING FOR OTHER  
10 MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND  
11 PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Implements State law by increasing  
from 1% to 2% the supplemental room tax.

10 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN  
11 AS FOLLOWS:

12 SECTION 1: Title 4, Chapter 20, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of  
13 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **4.20.010:** (A) The taxes imposed by Sections 4.20.030 and 4.20.080 are for the purpose of  
15 constructing and supporting convention halls and related facilities by the Las Vegas Convention and  
16 Visitors Authority for the benefit of the City and its residents and for the fulfillment of statutory  
17 requirements of NRS 244A.645 and any agreements of the City with the Las Vegas Convention and  
18 Visitors Authority and other government entities in Clark County, Nevada, in pursuance thereof  
19 concerning the pledge or commitment of these taxes.

20 (B) The taxes imposed by Section 4.20.035 are for the [purpose] purposes of  
21 supporting the [Nevada Department of Economic Development and] State fund for the promotion of  
22 tourism; advertising the resources of the City which are related to tourism, including available  
23 accommodations, transportation, entertainment, natural resources and climate, and to promote special  
24 events which are related thereto[.]; and supporting capital projects of the Clark County School  
25 District.

26 (C) The taxes imposed by Section 4.20.037 are for the purposes of providing funds  
27 for:

28 (1) Constructing, acquiring, improving, operating or maintaining urban

1 projects, or any combination thereof, including, without limitation, recreational facilities and other  
2 projects designed to encourage tourism or to improve the aesthetic environment of the central business  
3 area located within the boundaries of the district described in Appendix A of this Chapter.

4 (2) Paying the principal and interest on notes, bonds or other obligations  
5 issued by the City to fund such projects; or

6 (3) Any combination of those uses.

7 SECTION 2: Title 4, Chapter 20, Section 35, of the Municipal Code of the City of  
8 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **4.20.035:** There is fixed and imposed a supplemental tax on all room revenues derived by each hotel,  
10 motel or other establishment located within the City which offers rooms to the public on a daily basis  
11 or for periods of less than one week [which are located within the City,] in the amount of [one] two  
12 percent of all moneys received from room rentals by that establishment.

13 SECTION 3: Title 4, Chapter 20, Section 100, of the Municipal Code of the City of  
14 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **4.20.100:** Any licensee or operator failing to pay the taxes imposed by Section 4.20.030,  
16 4.20.035, 4.20.037, and 4.20.080 by the due dates provided by this Chapter shall pay in addition to  
17 such tax, a penalty of ten percent of the amount thereof, plus interest on the amount of such  
18 delinquency at the rate of one and one-half percent per month, or fraction thereof, from the date when  
19 such tax became due and payable until the date of payment.

20 SECTION 4: Title 4, Chapter 20, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of the City of  
21 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 **4.20.160:** The Director of the Department of Finance and [Computer] Business Services of the City  
23 shall, within twenty days from the close of the preceding calendar month, transmit:

24 (A) The total amount received pursuant to Sections 4.20.030 and 4.20.080 to the  
25 Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority to be used for the purposes set forth in subsection (A)  
26 of Section 4.20.010;

27 (B) Three-eighths of the [total amount] first one percent received pursuant to  
28 Section 4.20.035 to the Nevada Department of Taxation for deposit with the State Treasurer for credit

1 to the fund for the promotion of tourism;

2 (C) Five-eighths of the [total amount] first one percent received pursuant to Section  
3 4.20.035 to the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority to be used for the purposes set forth in  
4 subsection (B) of Section 4.20.010[.];

5 (D) The remaining proceeds received pursuant to Section 4.20.035 to the Clark  
6 County Treasurer for deposit in the Clark County School District's fund for capital projects; and

7 [(D)] (E) The total amount received pursuant to Section 4.20.037 to the treasury of the City  
8 to be used as provided in Section 4.20.010(C), as directed by the City Council.

9 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or  
10 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid  
11 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or  
12 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the  
13 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,  
14 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,  
15 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,  
16 invalid or ineffective.

17 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,  
18 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
19 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


